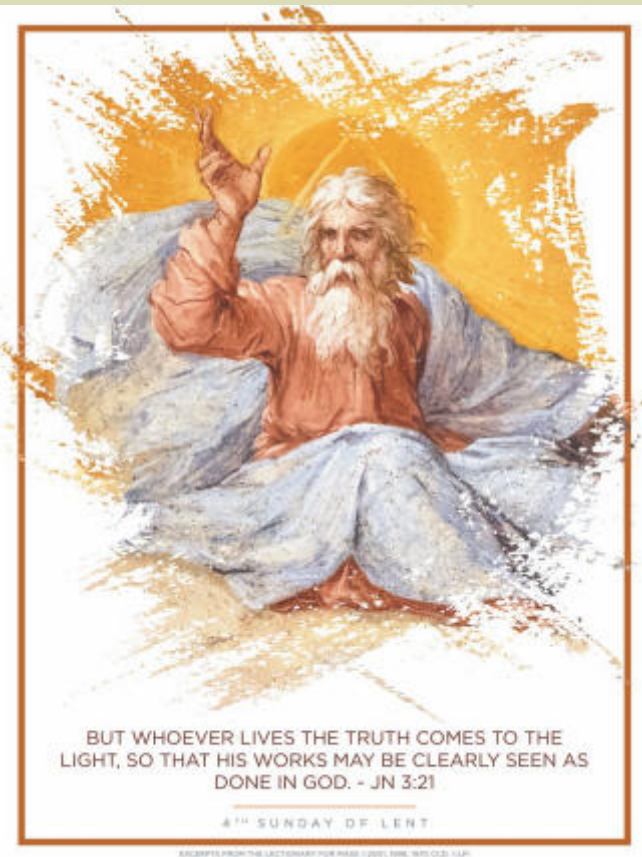

4th Sunday in Lent

Some time ago, I had to explain to a former Catholic who now belongs to a non-denominational church the essence of Catholic worship. I took the person near the sanctuary of our church and asked about the prominent features of the sanctuary that are different from her church. What stood out for her was the crucifix which is not in her church sanctuary. When a non-Catholic Christian asks us, “Why do you Catholics have Jesus on a cross? Didn’t he resurrect,” how should we respond?

Often, I ponder the crucifixion by recalling the scene from the movie *The Passion of Christ* when large nails were driven through the hands and feet of Jesus by brutal soldiers. This was no small sacrifice by Jesus. He took upon himself all our sins because of his commitment to fulfill his Father’s will, and because of his great love for us. When we inflict pain on others through our harsh words and actions, it’s as if we are pounding the nails into the hands and feet of Jesus. Perhaps we discriminate against others, judging others because of their color, intelligence, income level, or name. At times we forget that we are to live as a brother or sister to all people.



Our Lord invites us to look at the cross on which he was nailed and died. As we gaze at the crucifix, we are reminded that sometimes we have to take the difficult path of sacrifice which at times forego comfort and success. When some type of suffering comes our way, we are called to follow Our Lord’s footsteps, embracing our cross daily and carrying it with the strength and inspiration that is the fruit of our prayer before the crucifix.

The crucifix is not only a visible reminder of our sins and rejection of God, but also a powerful testament of God’s love for us and promise of resurrection, as John attests in our Gospel:

“For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.” St. Paul also reminds us, “God, who is rich in mercy, because of the great love he had for us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, brought us to life with Christ — by grace you have been saved.”

In a few weeks, we will lift up the cross during our Good Friday service. As we ponder about the cross Jesus embraced and the cross that Our Lord is asking us to embrace, let it sink into our hearts that when we gaze at His Cross, we will be healed, “Behold, behold, the wood of the Cross. On which is hung our salvation. O’ Come let us adore!”

As Catholic Christians we believe in and trust in all that has followed that day of crucifixion ... We believe in the Resurrection of Christ and that we too will be with Jesus in heaven one day.

Crucifix which turned and spoke to St. Bridget of Sweden when she visited the Basilica of St. Paul's Outside the Walls in Rome.

At the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls in Rome, Italy, one may notice the strange contortion of the neck of Jesus on the crucifix above the Tabernacle in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. Once St. Bridget of Sweden lay prostrate in prayer before this crucifix when Christ’s head miraculously turned toward her and gave her the famous “15 Prayers of St. Bridget.” Many pilgrims have devotion to these prayers, which are outlined in the well-known blue “Pieta” prayer book.



Prayer of St. Bridget of Sweden

O Lord, make haste and illumine the night. Say to my soul that nothing happens without You permitting it, and that nothing of what You permit is without comfort. O Jesus, Son of God, You Who were silent in the presence of Your accusers, restrain my tongue until I find what I should say and how to say it. Show me the way and make me ready to follow it. It is dangerous to delay, yet perilous to go forward. Answer my petition and show me the way. As the wounded go to the doctor in search of aid, so do I come to You. O Lord, give Your peace to my heart. Amen.

The Consecration Prayer is provided below and will be displayed on the overhead screens in the Church at the time of the Consecration.

Act of Consecration to St. Joseph



O Glorious Patriarch and Patron of the Church! O Virgin Spouse of the Virgin Mother of God! O Guardian and Virginal Father of the Word Incarnate! In the presence of Jesus and Mary, I choose you this day to be my father, my guardian, my protector.

O great St. Joseph, whom God has made the Head of the Holy Family, accept me, I beseech you, though utterly unworthy, to be a member of your "Holy House." Present me to your Immaculate Spouse; ask her also to adopt me as her child. With her, pray that I may constantly think of Jesus, and serve him faithfully to the end of my life.

O Terror of Demons, increase in me virtue, protect me from the evil one, and help me not to offend God in any way. O my Spiritual Father, I hereby consecrate myself to you. In faithful imitation of Jesus and Mary, I place myself and all my concerns under your care and protection.

To you, after Jesus and Mary, I consecrate my body and soul, with all their faculties, my spiritual growth, my home, and all my affairs and undertakings. Forsake me not, but adopt me as a servant and child of the Holy Family.

Watch over me at all times, but especially at the hour of my death. Console and strengthen me with the presence of Jesus and Mary so that, with you, I may praise and adore the Holy Trinity for all eternity. Amen.

CHILDREN OF GOD MAUSOLEUM SEEKS ADDITIONAL DONATIONS

Thanks to the generosity of individuals and organizations, we have collected nearly all of the \$120,000 initial cost to build the *Children of God Mausoleum* dedicated to miscarriage, still born, and early infant deaths. This mausoleum is a humanitarian effort to provide a dignified and respectful resting place for those suffering tragic loss in the Baton Rouge area. The estimated time of completion for this mausoleum will be Fall of 2022.

During the detail design phase, we've added an extra level to the mausoleum to increase the capacity so that we would have ample space for future burials. The addition of the extra level requires reinforcement of the concrete foundation of the mausoleum. And the area surrounding the mausoleum will have poured concrete for easier access. These design changes increase the overall projected cost of the mausoleum to \$220,000. While the initial smaller mausoleum design would have served us for a few years, we believe that the needs will be greater in the coming years as St. George is the only Catholic cemetery serving the Baton Rouge area.

Please prayerfully consider donating to this worthy cause. May St. Joseph assist us in providing solace and comfort to parents who have lost their dear children.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY: AED DEVICE

There is an advanced AED (Emergency Defibrillator) located in the narthex of church. The AED is a life-saving device to be used in emergencies only. If the door of the cabinet is opened an alarm will briefly sound (please note that the alarm will stop on its own). Once the cabinet is opened, the cabinet and device must be sanitized and reconditioned by a certified technician. Please notify the parish office at (225) 293-2212 if you open the AED cabinet. After hours or on weekends, you may leave a message to notify us that the cabinet needs to be sanitized.

St. George is grateful to parishioner Pat Chidester who serves as our registered AED Device Administrator. Pat monitors and maintains this device so it will be ready should the need arise. Thank you Pat!

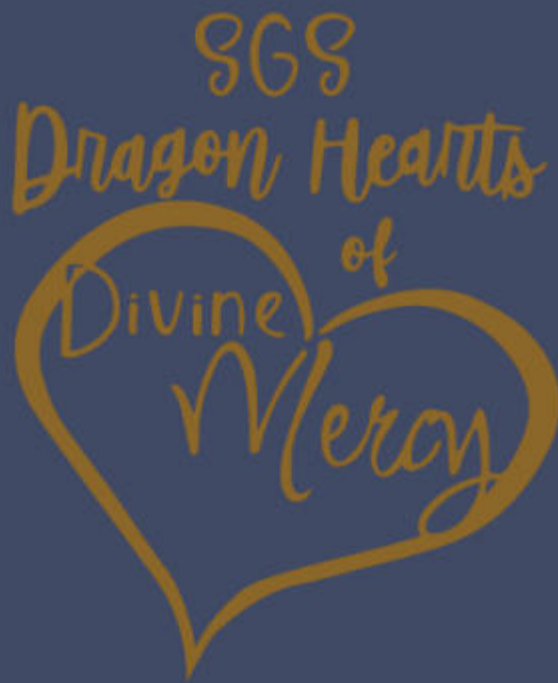
