DeAndra'e Woods is an alumnus of our very own track and field program. He was a sprinter from 2008-12 and was a team captain from 2010-12. After he finished competing at Cal State Fullerton, he volunteered and then interned

for the Titans strength & conditioning coaches. After this, he became one of Concordia University Irvine's track & field graduate assistants, where he had athletes break records in the 60-meter dash (indoor), 4x400m relay (indoor), 4x100m relay (outdoor), and the 4x400m relay (outdoor). He also helped coach the 4x100m relay team to the PacWest championship in 2016. After his graduate assistantship ended at CUI, he became the head coach for Chapman's track & field/cross country program, where he stayed for three and a half years. Currently, he is the sprints/hurdles/relays coach at CUI.

DeAndra'e has extensive knowledge of what it takes to be a student-athlete and the skills athletes learn that are valuable outside of sport. DeAndra'e will share his journey, what he's learned, and how to market the valuable skills athletes possess.



The OCFA is an all-risk fire department responding to incidents such as medical aids, structure and wildland fires, hazardous materials, traffic collisions, etc. There are many opportunities for employees to grow their skill set at the OCFA. After passing the academy and completing a 1-year probationary period, operations personal can apply to attend paramedic school, a hazardous materials technician, urban search & rescue, aircraft rescue, and firefighter at John Wayne airport. 





Required Qualifications: Specific qualifications vary according to the requirements of the position. A background check (including a criminal records check) must be completed satisfactorily before any candidate can be offered a position with the CSU. Failure to satisfactorily complete the background check may affect the application status of applicants or continued employment of current CSU employees who apply for the position.

Temporary Pool

Required Qualifications: The same as staff positions.

Benefits: Temporary employees are eligible for 6 2/3 hours of vacation & 8 hours of sick leave per 160 hours worked.

Salary Range: Starting at \$16.80 per hour

Student Assistant Positions

A student may be eligible to work on-campus as a student employee if they are a current student at CSUF and is enrolled/registered (fees paid) in a current regular semester as a new or continuing student; a student who has completed the prior semester (has not graduated), or who is registered for the subsequent semester; in good academic standing and can provide employment eligibility documents. Students employed through the Federal Work Study Program must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 units (undergraduate) or 4 units (graduate), and must not be on academic probation. In most cases, international students can be employed on-campus. Work hours are strictly limited to 20 hours per week during regular semester class sessions. Additional details are available at
