TURNING LEAVES with Bonnie Hwang



Bonnie's love of Modern Art and love of nature has greatly influenced her quilting and can be seen through her incredible use of colour and distinctive designs.

The freehand cut curve technique produces an inimitable freeform leaf design. The offset contrasting background adds a dynamic quality to the wall hanging. Slender stems that separate the coordinating leaf fabrics add an additional challenge taking this quilt from a beginner to an intermediate level.



MYSTERY QUILT WORKSHOP With Carol Piercy



Carol Piercy has been on a roll creating a mystery quilt for a guild workshop. This workshop is for everyone and has no 1/2 square triangles!! Plan to come out for a day of fun and lots of sewing.

Workshop Cancellation Policy:

- If a class overfills on the first night of registration, there will be a lottery.
- If a class does not fill on the first night of registration, the workshop committee will decide if the class will go ahead.
- If a class does go ahead all those registered on the first night would be guaranteed a spot. Further registrations would be collected on a first come basis.
- In other words, if you really want to attend a workshop make sure you get your cheque into the workshop committee in person, by mail or with a friend by the first night of registration.

If you must withdraw from a workshop for which you have registered, please remember that YOU are responsible for filing your space before your monies will be refunded.

- Change your needle (hand and machine) after each quilt to make sure that it is always sharp and penetrates well.
- If your thread tangles, try turning the spool around, top to bottom. This often will fix the problem.

From your Programme Committee

I don't know if anybody had as much fun as I did in last month's Sewing Room Scavenger Hunt. I will admit that I had a slight advantage in that on Sunday night upon my return from a fabulous Guild Retreat I actually organized my sewing/quilting gadgets so they were all in one place. I am happy to say that I haven't had to use the nifty new stitch "adjusters" that I won but I'm sure they will see some use sooner rather than later.



For this month's meeting we have arranged for Joan from Classic Stitch, the local representative for Superior Threads, to come and talk about thread. Joan will be bringing her thread (and more importantly her credit card machine) with her so bring any projects you are working on so you can find the ideal thread to finish your masterpiece.

In addition, we will be introducing a SECRET MUG RUG swap. What is a mug rug? Well, it is a wee little quilt approx. 10" x 6" for your mug of tea, coffee or hot cocoa...bigger than a coaster but smaller than a placemat. At the March guild meeting we will be handing out brown paper bags to all those who wish to participate. Inside those bags will be a list of 3 to 5 simple questions for you to answer. We ask that before the start of the April meeting you return



your brown paper bag with your questions answered and with 3 or 4 scraps (approx 4" x 4") of your favourite fabrics. During break we will redistribute the brown paper bags. You will have two months to make a mug rug for your Secret Swap Partner using some of the fabrics in the bag and with the questions in mind. We will exchange the finished mug rugs at the June meeting. The finished mug rugs should be made with 100% cotton, be quilted and bound securely (no zig zag edges) and with a label to your Secret Swap Partner from you. When we hand out the brown paper bags at the March meeting we will also include printed rules for you to follow.

Can't make a meeting but would like to participate – don't worry! For those of you who can't make the March meeting but would like to participate just contact me. I can send you the questions and rules and we can quickly put your answers and fabric into a bag at the April meeting. For those of you who would like to participate but are worried that you won't be able to make the June meeting. Don't worry we can make some arrangements for you too.

I would like to take this chance to say a big thank you to Elaine Thody, Leslie Chatelain and Kathleen Cosgrove for the work they have done this past year.

Also, I would like to take a minute to introduce Jo Ann Lee and Paula Bohan who have graciously agreed to help me with Programs for the rest of the term.
