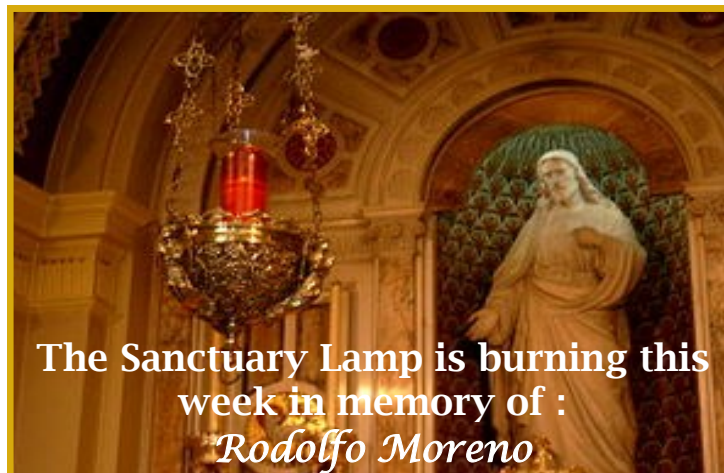

Why Did Jesus Enter Jerusalem?



We might wonder why Jesus entered Jerusalem as He did, on Palm Sunday. Didn't He know of the great danger that was awaiting Him? Of course He was well aware of what would happen to Him there. In fact, one did not have to be a prophet to know that Jerusalem was the stronghold of His enemies, the Jewish religious leaders, who were planning to arrest Him and kill Him! Jesus deliberately chose to enter Jerusalem in order there to make His great sacrifice of love, by suffering and dying for us.

Perhaps the only and beloved Son of God chose to give up His life in Jerusalem because that is where, centuries before, God had asked Abraham to sacrifice his only and beloved son Isaac (Genesis 22). Isaac had carried the wood for his own sacrifice up the hill, as Jesus would carry the wood for His own sacrifice up the hill of Cavalry. Abraham ended up offering a lamb for the sacrifice in place of his son, as Jesus was the Lamb of God Who was sacrificed in our place. In this way we can see that Abraham's sacrifice of great faith and love was a kind of a prophecy of the sacrifice of Jesus.

Hundreds of years before the birth of Jesus, the prophet Zechariah foretold of a great king who would ride into Jerusalem, not as a warrior on a horse, but as a humble man of peace, on a donkey: **"Exult greatly, O daughter Zion! Shout for joy, O daughter Jerusalem! Behold: your king is coming to you, a just savior is he, humble, and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."** (Zechariah 9:9) Many of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, who would have known this prophecy very well, no doubt believed that Jesus was their long awaited Messiah, the descendant of King David who was fulfilling this prophecy. And so they greeted Him with great joy on Palm Sunday.

As we re-live the events of Holy Week, it is amazing to see how so many things that Jesus did and how so many things that were done to Jesus, actually fulfilled the Biblical prophecies that had been made centuries before. God clearly knew in advance everything that would happen, so it would have been a simple matter for Jesus to have avoided the Cross. But this shows us that Jesus freely chose to give up His life for our sake. As He Himself said, **"Nobody takes My life from Me, but I lay it down on My own"** (John 10:18).

Let us actively re-live the events of Holy Week, those acts of love by which Jesus made possible our salvation. May our devoted participation in these liturgies help us to also carry our crosses with great love, knowing that as Jesus overcame every evil, so by our union with Him we can also overcome every evil and join in His Resurrection victory.

¿Por qué Jesús entró en Jerusalén?

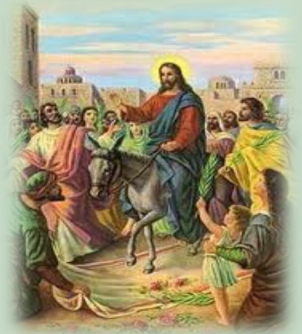
Podríamos preguntarnos, ¿por qué Jesús entró en Jerusalén como lo hizo el Domingo de Ramos? ¿No sabía Él del gran peligro que lo estaba esperando? Por supuesto, él estaba muy consciente de lo que le sucedería ahí. De hecho, uno no tenía que ser un profeta para saber que Jerusalén era el fuerte de sus enemigos, los líderes religiosos judíos, ¡que planeaban arrestarlo y matarlo! Jesús escogió deliberadamente entrar en Jerusalén para hacer su gran sacrificio de amor, sufriendo y muriendo por nosotros.

Tal vez el único y amado Hijo de Dios escogió renunciar a su vida en Jerusalén porque ahí es donde, siglos antes, Dios le había pedido a Abraham que sacrificara a su único y amado hijo Isaac (Génesis 22). Isaac había llevado la leña para su propio sacrificio colina arriba, como Jesús llevaría la leña para su propio sacrificio hasta la colina del calvario. Abraham terminó ofreciendo un cordero para el sacrificio en lugar de su hijo, como Jesús era el Cordero de Dios que fue sacrificado en nuestro lugar. De esta manera podemos ver que el sacrificio de Abraham de gran fe y amor fue una especie de profecía del sacrificio de Jesús.

Cientos de años antes del nacimiento de Jesús, el profeta Zacarías predijo acerca de un gran rey que cabalgaría a Jerusalén, no como un guerrero montado en un caballo, sino como un hombre humilde de paz, montado en un asno: *“Salta, llena de gozo, oh hija de Sion, lanza gritos de alegría, hija de Jerusalén. Pues tu rey viene hacia ti; él es santo y victorioso, humilde, y va montado sobre un burro, sobre el hijo pequeño de una burra.”* (Zacarías 9: 9). Muchos de los habitantes de Jerusalén, que conocían esta profecía muy bien, sin duda sabían que Jesús era su tan esperado Mesías, el descendiente del Rey David que estaba cumpliendo esta profecía. Y entonces lo saludaron con gran alegría el Domingo de Ramos.

Al volver a vivir los eventos de la Semana Santa, es sorprendente ver tantas cosas que Jesús hizo y cuántas cosas se le hicieron a Jesús que, realmente cumplieron las profecías bíblicas que se habían hecho siglos antes. Dios claramente sabía de antemano todo lo que le sucedería, por lo que habría sido tan simple para Jesús haber evitado la Cruz. Pero esto nos muestra que Jesús escogió libremente renunciar a su vida por nosotros. Como Él mismo dijo, *“Nadie me la quita, sino que yo mismo la entrego.”* (Juan 10:18).

Reviviremos activamente los eventos de la Semana Santa, aquellos actos de amor por los cuales Jesús hizo posible nuestra salvación. Que nuestra participación devota en estas liturgias, nos ayuden a llevar nuestras cruces con gran amor, sabiendo que cuando Jesús venció todo mal, también por nuestra unión con Él podemos vencer todo mal y unirnos en Su victoria de Resurrección.

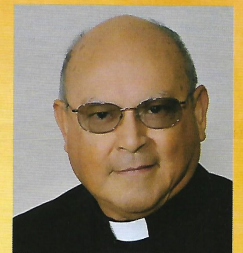

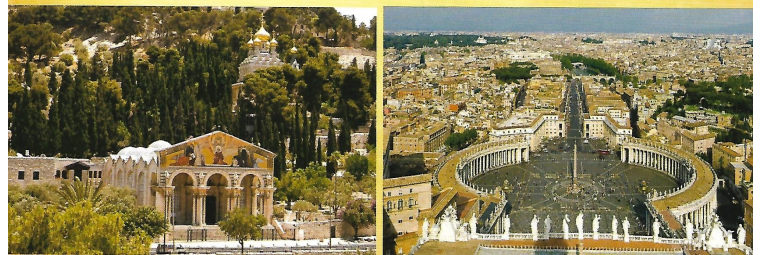
