All U.S. citizens – including minors – are required to present a valid passport or passport card for travel into the Bahamas. For the latest entry requirements, visit www.travel.state.gov. All Canadian citizens need a valid passport to enter the Bahamas as well, and information can be obtained at www.bahamas.com/entry-requirements.

Grand Hyatt Baha Mar Check-in

Arrivals & Transportation

- The Grand Hyatt Baha Mar is situated in the center of Cable Beach on the Northern Shore of New Providence Island and is located 14 minutes from the Lynden Pindling International Airport (commonly known as Nassau International Airport – NAS). Taxis are readily available from the airport and the resort. Private transportation is available to and from the airport for a cost. To make transportation arrangements, please contact concierge.nasgh@hyatt.com prior to your arrival.
- Transportation is provided to all off-site events and activities. Taxis are readily available at the hotel to take you to area restaurants.
- Valet Parking – Valet parking is available for \$19 per day. Payment can be made via debit or credit cards, no cash. Guests are not able to charge valet parking to their guest room folio.
- Self-Parking – The self-parking lot is free and is located beside the convention center.

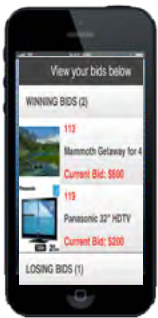
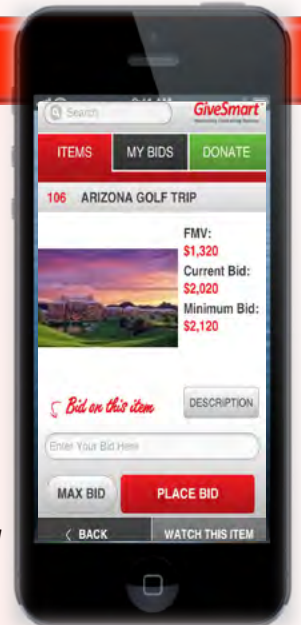

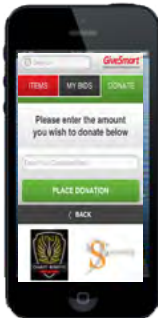
