We have had a successful year of films at Catholic Movie Night, and I am still working on preparing the lineup of great Catholic movies for the first six months of 2022! However, in these final couple of months of 2021, I am pleased to be bringing you two great movies. **Tonight, come see an Alfred Hitch-cock classic called** *I Confess* **at 6 pm in the Parish Center.** Admission is free. *I Confess* stars Montgomery Clift, Anne Baxter, and Karl Malden and tells the story of a priest that hears the confession of a murderer and then is accused of the murder himself. He is unable to clear his name because of the seal of confession, which prohibits all Catholic priests from revealing any information heard in the confessional. It is an engaging and interesting movie beautifully filmed on location in Quebec City, Canada. You can also enjoy some delicious refreshments at our Concession Stand!
