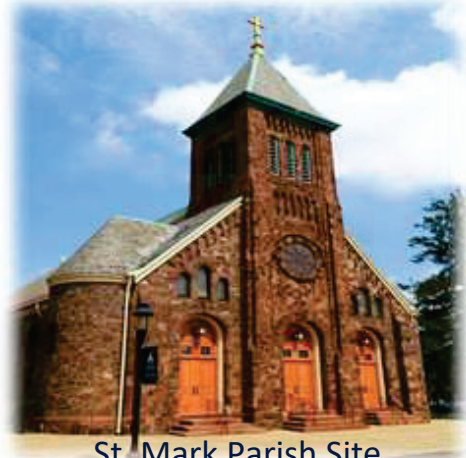
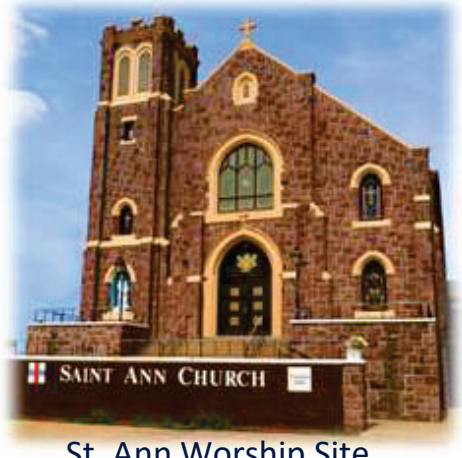

My Dear Friends,

In this Sunday's Gospel from Luke, Jesus tells us we need to be just as clever in planning for a secure future for ourselves, and not just for the few years we are on this earth that we have to provide, but also for our time in eternity. Father Richard DeLillio, OSFS, whom I often quote, has a further reflection on our Gospel, he writes; *"The late Venerable Bishop Fulton Sheen, a popular TV communicator, reminded millions of TV viewers each week, 'life is worth living.' He would approve of the following comments from today's readings: by our presence (as followers of Jesus) in the world, we are called to create a society capable of recognizing the dignity of every person and sharing the gift that each person is to the other...the (action of the steward), this action is commended by his master because he acted with decisiveness in a moment of crisis. Jesus commands his enterprising and shrewd choices. The parable has nothing else to say about any other aspects of his moral comportment. 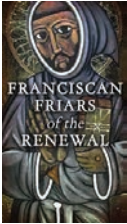


