1. A refundable \$5.00 deposit for the permit entry card and card programming will be required in addition to the permit fee. Please note, if payment is received after the grace period, a reactivation fee of \$5.00 per permit will be charged.	
2. Wharf II permits shall only be issued to those who have boats at A or H Tier and must be verified with the Harbormaster.	
3. Permit fees are non-refundable. If you desire to change your billing option, it will become effective the following quarter. You may not switch billing options during the quarter.	
4. A replacement fee of \$10 per permit will be charged for lost or stolen paper permits.	
5. An administrative fee of \$10 will be charged to dismiss a parking citation for failure to display a proper permit.	
6. Grace periods: Monthly Permits - 2 days, Quarterly Permits - 5 days, Annual Permits - 10 days	
7. Permit Pro-rate Information: Monthly - on the 15th of each month, Quarterly - on the 1st and 15th of each month, Annual - None.	
8. Monterey Residents may purchase a decal for \$20/year that will allow them two hour parking in the Downtown Garages, Cannery Row Garage and the Waterfront Lot.	
9. Effective 01/01/09, the Fisherman's Wharf Party Boat discount rate for the Waterfront lot for the period of Memorial Day through Labor Day shall be \$7/day and \$5/day the remaining time of the year.	
10. Effective 01/01/09, the monthly charge for a net storage in the Depot Lot shall be \$50/space.	
11. Boot Removal Fee is \$75.00.	
12. The City Manager or their designee shall have the authority to set a flat parking rate in any attendant parking facility up to the approved maximum daily rate for said facility.
