Degree
Eligibility**

- Have been enrolled at Evergreen for a minimum of one quarter.
- Is on track to graduate with their bachelor's degree prior to enrolling in the Fall quarter of the MiT program (graduating in Spring or Summer).
- Transfer students must complete their final 45 credits at Evergreen, which can include the 12 undergraduate credits in the MiT Program.



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**UG/GR
Combined
Degree
Process**

- Undergraduate students are provisionally admitted to MiT.
- The first term (12 credits) of MiT are taken as an undergraduate.
- The successful completion of the first 12 credits in MiT completes the undergraduate degree.
- Upon completion of the undergraduate degree, they are officially admitted into MiT to complete 48 more credits for their MiT degree.
