# Sub Hub 2021 Rules 

Safety First and 3-Man Scramble

## Safety First Tournament

Each team will be given an official yellow neon ball, to be played on each hole, alternating between members of the team. The team chooses any order for playing the neon ball, but that order must be maintained throughout the round. The neon ball must always be holed out despite how many strokes it takes. You can't just "pick it up." You will have a separate scorecard to record the neon ball score.

## Yellow Neon Ball Rotation

Player 1 plays the Neon Ball on holes 1, 5, 9, 13, 17
Player 2 plays the Neon Ball on holes 2, 6, 10, 14, 18

Player 3 plays the Neon Ball on holes 3, 7, 11, 15
Player 4 plays the Neon Ball on holes 4, 8, 12, 16

- The neon ball must be used for the entire hole and always holed out.
- The neon ball shall never be deemed unfit for play.
- The official neon ball shall be turned in, if available, with the scorecard.
- Should no team complete the round with the neon ball, the winner will be based on the number of holes fully completed.
- A ball is "lost" if it is not found within three minutes after the search has begun. However, if you can find it, and retrieve it - it's still in play. (Penalty strokes no doubt will be in order.)
- If/when the yellow neon ball is lost, the player who loses it will don the "Safety First" Reflective Yellow Vest. The safety vest must also be worn the rest of the round.

3-Man Scramble - The "other" 3 team members will play a 3-man scramble. You will have a separate scorecard for recording the scramble score. If/when your $4^{\text {th }}$ partner loses the neon ball, he will join the group starting on the next tee box and the group will begin playing a 4-man elimination scramble.

Tees/Misc.: All play will be from the blue tees. Once you team is safely on the $9^{\text {th }}$ green, Mike will "show you the line" by hitting the team's first putt. Meanwhile, Larry will hit a tee shot on the Par $3-13^{\text {th }}$ hole with each group. (He will not hit the neon ball.) Their shots can be substituted for any one member of the groups' shot - except the player playing the neon ball. (The neon ball player for that hole is on his own.) If the team no longer has the neon ball, and the team decides to use Mike's putt or Larry tee shot, one team member will be "eliminated" from hitting the next shot (team choice). Of course you are under no obligation, and in many, many instances will have no interest, in using their shot. *Be advised, there may be an additional "celebrity guest player" or two....

## Tie Break:

Scramble - Ties will be broken by back-tracking scores from Hole \#18.
Safety First - If multiple teams finish with the yellow neon ball, the winner will be determined by the lowest neon ball score. Otherwise, top team will be determined by number of holes completed, and if still tied, by the lowest neon ball score for those fully completed holes.

Scramble: $1^{\text {st }}-\$ 400,2^{\text {nd }}-\$ 240,3^{\text {rd }}-\$ 100$
Safety First: $1^{\text {st }}-\$ 300,2^{\text {nd }}-\$ 160,3^{\text {rd }}-\$ 80$

## Tourney Format / Rules

## $1^{\text {st }}$ Round: 2-Man Scramble - A/C, B/D <br> Thursday 8:00am Shotgun Start, Canyons Course, Blue Tees

Regular scramble format for the $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{C}$ team with the following putting modifications: "A" players will putt solo on all odd-numbered holes, "C" players will putt solo on all even-numbered holes. Once the ball is on the "green" (not the fringe), only the one (1) designated player will be allowed to putt.

Regular scramble for the B/D partners; both players hit each shot and team selects which ball to play.

As a reminder, on all scrambles, you may improve your lie, but not your position. (in the trap, stay in the trap; in the rough, stay in the rough, etc.)

## 2nd Round: 2-Man Scramble - A/B, C/D Friday 8:00am Shotgun Start, Oaks Course, Green Tees

Regular scramble format for the A/B team with the following putting modifications: "A" players will putt solo on all odd-numbered holes, "B" players will putt solo on all even-numbered holes. Once the ball is on the "green" (not the fringe), only the one (1) designated player will be allowed to putt. In addition, on the Par 5 holes (\#2, \#8, \#14, \& \#18), the A/B team will play from the Gold Tees.

Regular scramble format for the C/D team. Both players hit each shot and team selects which ball to play.

For the Chapman Format (aka Pinehurst System) both partners tee off, then teammates switch balls for their $2^{\text {nd }}$ shot (player \#1 hits player \#2's drive, player \#2 hits player \#1's drive). After both balls lay two (2), the team will select the one best ball they elect to play; and scramble from there.

Be careful on Par 3's as the ball needs to lay 2 before you start scrambling. We typically get into scramble-mode once we get on the green, and on a Par 3, if the ball lies one (1), you are still putting solo for the first putt, until the ball lays 2.

A few notes:

- Before the round, exchange scorecards with your playing partners and keep each other's score.
- Please write legibly only on the official scorecard and in the marked area only. (If you want to keep your own score or make notes, please do it on a separate card.) One player from each team must verify the score on all holes for accuracy, and both cards should be signed by someone from each team before turning them in.
- Each team is responsible for their official scorecard upon completion of the round. Please be sure it is turned in to the appropriate person responsible for collecting them.
- Please remember that everyone should hit from their assigned tees on all par 3's - A's Gold, B's Blue, C's Green, and D's Red. This is true for all par 3's during all 3 rounds of the tournament, regardless of the format.
- Please note the putting modifications when applicable.
- Please note during the $A / B$ round they will use the Gold Tees on each of the Par 5's.
- Triple bogey is the max score on any hole.
- Please be cognizant of the pace of play and do all you can to keep up with the group in front of you.
- "Hubbell Whiff Rule" (much like the 3-knockdown rule) is always in effect. A complete miss allows for a do-over.
- If you are the last group playing one of the Par 3's, someone from your group should be assigned to bring in the Closest-to-the-Pin marker and get it to a collection person. Please help him remember to do so.
- Finally, do the right thing. When in doubt, ask or check with your playing partners.

## 2021 Shoot Out Rules

## Thursday, 3:30pm, Holes 1-5, The Canyons Course

We are again playing in 3-man teams but this year we will play a modified "Elimination Scramble" as one each hole, we will have only one tee shot per team. We have 25 teams (75 players) and the 25 teams will be split into 5 groups of 5 teams, and these 5 groups will start on

Holes $1,2,3,4, \& 5$ of the Canyons Course. We will rotate thru these 5 holes, so after playing the $5^{\text {th }}$ hole, you will then go play hole \#1. Everyone will play from the Blue Tees (even on the Par 3) and each group will play three (3) holes. The team with the low total score after these 3 holes will be crowned the "group winner."

In a slight modification, only 1 player from each team will tee off on each hole. On the first hole, the team will decide which team member will tee off (a total of 5 shots). After the team's lone tee shot, the other 2 teammates will hit the $2^{\text {nd }}$ shot (just like playing a scramble). The player whose shot is used for the $2^{\text {nd }}$ shot will sit out the next shot, and the $3^{\text {rd }}$ shot will be played by the other 2 team members. Basically, 2 guys will hit every shot except the tee shot, and if your shot is used, you will sit out the next shot. This format will be used through the entire hole, include any tap-in putts. The guy who makes the final putt from the previous hole will not be allowed to tee off on the next hole; the team will decide from their other 2 partners who will hit their 1 tee shot.

Each group will play 3 holes to establish the group winner. Total team score will determine the winning team. Teams tied after 3 holes will participate in a 1 -player putt-off from a spot determined by the group marshal. Only an eligible team member may hit this putt.

The 5 advancing teams will be in the finals - and in the money! These 5 teams will gather in the $1^{\text {st }}$ fairway at a "temporary tee box", approximately 100-120 yards from the green. We will use the same format and rules. To start the finals, the team can choose any team member to hit their one and only tee shot.

The tie-breaker rules for the finals will be a single, simultaneous putt by all those in the playoff from chosen spots on the green, equal distance from the hole. Each team will decide from their eligible players who will do the putting. Order of finish amongst these teams will be determined by closest-to-the-pin after this single putt.

We encourage everyone to stick around for the finals. The drink cart will be available.

> Team Payouts: $1^{\text {st }}$ Place $-\$ 750,2^{\text {nd }}$ Place $-\$ 300,3^{\text {rd }}$ Place $-\$ 225,4^{\text {th }}$ Place $-\$ 150,5^{\text {th }}$ Place $-\$ 75$

## Hole - in - One

Once again we had $100 \%$ participation in our Hole-in-One pledge of $\$ 10 /$ man. That simply means that if you are fortunate enough to "Ace" any hole during any of the 3 tournament rounds, you will collect $\$ 10$ from every person in the field - or a smooth $\$ 1,030$. We are absolutely overdue for an "Ace" so good luck to all!

We also instituted this $\$ 10 /$ man policy to be adhered to in the unlikely event someone scores a "double-eagle" on any of the Par 5's during the tournament. Unlikely, yes, but we have had it happen!

## Closest - to - the - Pin

Thanks to the generous donations of several players, we will again award $\$ 100$ to the Closest-to-the-Pin winner on every Par 3 during the tournament. That will be 12 winning shots -4 per round.

During Saturday's $3^{\text {rd }}$ Round, the famous $16^{\text {th }}$ hole at the Oaks Course will serve as the John Reitmeyer Memorial Hole, commemorating all the friends we have lost over the years. This closest-to-the pin winner will collect $\$ 250$.
