

The University of Florence offers about 60 two-year master's degree programs. Most of the programs are <u>taught in Italian</u>, while some are completely <u>taught in English</u>. To apply for a master's degree program, you must have completed an appropriate undergraduate degree program. You are not required to participate in any admission test: the board of professors of your intended master program will conduct a thorough review of your application and supplemental documents to evaluate your eligibility, according to the University requirements for that program. For more detailed information about applying to a master program, see the instructions referring to the School your intended program belongs to.






