



# ACADEMIC, APPLIED OR LOCALLY DEVELOPED?

#### **ACADEMIC**

#### **APPLIED**

 Develop student's knowledge and skills by emphasizing practical, concrete applications of the essential concepts while incorporating theoretical applications, as appropriate.



## Academic, Applied or Locally Developed?

#### **LOCALLY DEVELOPED**

- Locally Developed courses are intended for students who require flexibility and support in order to meet credit requirements.
- These courses are offered in Math, Science and English in Grade
  9.
- These courses review and reinforce the elementary curriculum expectations to provide the skills necessary for further study a the secondary level.
