Pentecost Sunday

"There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone." - 1 Corinthians 12:4-6

By giving each of us different gifts (CHARISMS), God made sure that the Church would have the right combination of time, talent and treasure that was needed to do His work. However, if one of us does not utilize our gifts, God's plan goes unfulfilled. Some important work is left undone.

**The Catholic Church recognizes the lack of and the need of each Catholic Christian to be familiar with St. Paul's teaching of Spiritual Gifts (Charisms). When we receive the Holy Spirit at Confirmation we become endowed with the power of God indwelling us. Thus, His power provides the ability and means of infilling us with supernatural abilities through the 20 Spiritual Gifts (for ministry) listed in Scripture. Each person receives the one/ones that God desires, according to his/her particular personality.

**It is a teaching that will challenge you to become the disciple/steward that God desires. It is powerful because we will no longer be serving God with only our human talents/abilities (which are sorely inadequate in the mystical kingdom of God). Instead St. Boniface will be truly fulfilling her task of God's Kingdom at St. Boniface.

**Watch for the next time our Stewardship Committee offers this valuable teaching and your ministry will take on an aura of Godliness that you never knew existed--because the power will be coming directly from our heavenly Father. You will not be disappointed when you allow God's Will to infill you. When you are serving God in the area to which you are CALLED there will be no "BURN-OUT". Try it and see!

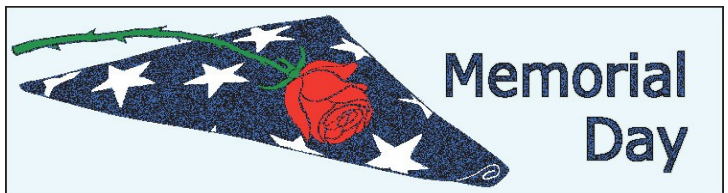

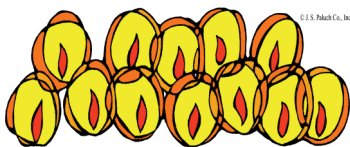
