



ELIGIBILITY

Juniors/Youth: Current USJI, USJA, USJF, Foreign National membership

Junior Competitors: 6 to 16 years - Minimum competition age is six (6) years of age on the day of the tournament

Youth Competitors: 17 to 19 years

Copies of Proof of Age and current membership must be sent with application or presented at registration to be

eligible to compete.

Seniors/Masters: Current USJI, USJA, USJF, Foreign National membership

Copy of current membership must be sent with application or presented at registration to be eligible to compete.

RULES

Modified IJF rules will apply. The tournament will use a Double Elimination Pairing System (with the exception of divisions of less than 4 competitors, those will be "round robin"). If an advertised division exceeds 20 competitors, the division will be divided into two divisions with awards being given in both.

For Saturday Competition— Shime-Waza (choking) techniques will be allowed for competitors ages 13 and up.

NO Kansetsu –Waza (armlock) techniques will be allowed in any Junior division on Saturday. They will be allowed in the Youth divisions.

Juniors may compete in additional Junior divisions and Senior divisions at the discretion of the tournament officials. Youth Divisions may compete in Senior Divisions. The tournament officials reserve the right to refuse a competitor the opportunity to compete if there is, in their opinion, a safety concern.

For Sunday Competition—Competitors in the Senior Divisions Men Black Belt (M-3) and Women (F-1) MUST have both blue and white gis. Kansetsu Waza is prohibited in the Senior Men (M1) Rokyu-Gokyu-Yonkyu Division

Competitors in M-3, F-1 and all Masters Divisions must be Dan Grade or present a completed, signed Participation Approval for Non-Black Belt Contestants form at registration

3 minutes: All Junior/Youth Divisions/ All Masters Divisions (M and F)/ Senior Men Rokyu through Ikkyu Divisions (M-1, M-2) Current IJF times will apply to Senior Men Black Belt Divisions / Senior Women Divisions

Junior and Youth boys who want to compete on Sunday will compete in the rank appropriate divisions. Junior and Youth girls who want to compete on Sunday will compete in the Senior Women's Division (F-1). Competitors under the age of 18 must have parental/guardian permission. The Additional Division fee of \$25 per division will apply. Competitors will not be required to weigh in again for Senior competition but will need to complete a Senior registration form. Their weight from the Junior or Youth weigh-in will be used.
