



Head Injuries

Maybe you are walking outside and it's raining or there is snow on the ground and you accidentally fall. You are sure that you hit your head on the sidewalk. You feel a little pain where your head hit the ground, but otherwise you feel fine. Nonetheless, you may be at high risk for serious complications if you are on any kind of blood thinner, if you are older in age, or if you have a diagnosis of osteopenia. Anyone with these risk factors should immediately seek medical care as these risk factors could lead to a brain bleed and possible death. Per Harvard Health Publishing, each year in the United States there are more than 2 million emergency room visits related to head injuries, 72,000 deaths related to head injuries, and an additional 80,000 to 210,000 people with moderate to severe head injuries who became disabled or require extended hospital care.

- *Skull Fracture A skull fracture is a crack or break in the bones of the skull.
- *Epidural Hematoma An epidural hematoma is a very serious bleeding of the brain and occurs when one of the blood vessels under the skull is torn during an injury.
- *Acute Subdural Hematoma An acute subdural hematoma can occur when a serious head trauma occurs (i.e., assault, car accident, or fall) causing the blood vessels Health Enews Health Enews and blood to collect between the dura and the surface of the brain.
- *Chronic Subdural Hematoma Unlike an acute subdural hematoma, a chronic subdural hematoma occurs gradually because the bleeding in the skull is less dramatic and the hematoma can accumulate in several small separate episodes of bleeding
- *Concussion A concussion is a traumatic brain injury (TBI) that can be caused by a bump, blow, or jolt to the head by a hit to the body that causes the head and brain to move rapidly back and forth.

Symptoms of Head Injury—

Fatigue • Feeling depressed or anxious • Concentration problems • Difficulty sleeping • Loss of balance • Dilation of one or both pupils • Loss of coordination • Weakness or numbness in fingers and toes • Problems with speech • A bad taste in the mouth • Changes in ability to smell • Mood changes or mood swing.


