

A Message from Fr. Matt

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Happy Mother's Day to all of our Moms! Whether you'll be with your Mom today for brunch or dinner, or spiritually because she's in Heaven like my Mom, I hope you spend some time loving your Mom today and being loved by her.

Last week we heard the word "remain" an amazing 13 times. It was a not-so-subtle hint from God and His Church that we should focus on what that word means. This week we hear the word "love" 21 times! So, I guess the Lord wants us to focus on love, right? What do you think Jesus means when He commands us at the end of the Gospel to love one another?

Over the past year we have had to do many things differently or not at all. One of the "not at alls" that I miss is the jersey swap. If you have never seen it, sometimes at the end of a game, usually football or soccer, players swap jerseys. Often, it is a star player on one team swapping with an opposing star player. The jersey swap is a sign of respect or recognition. There is a phrase, "real recognizes real." I saw a picture of D.K. Metcalf from the Seahawks trading jerseys with Julio Jones of the Falcons after a hard fought game. The jersey swap doesn't mean they are



the same. It doesn't mean that they like everything about the other. It doesn't mean that they'd rather be on the other team or have the other team win. It just means that the players recognize the goodness, the gifts and talents of the other. They recognize and respect each other and so they swap jerseys. Real recognizes real.

When Jesus gives us the command to love one another, he is calling us to this "real recognizes real" encounter. Jesus is calling us not to just like one another, or to be the same as the other. He is calling us to recognize that we are beloved by God and so is the other person. This beloved-ness is not dependent on anything we have done. In the Second Reading St. John says, "In this is love: Not that we have loved God, but that He loved us." God loves us first. We are called, commanded

really, to recognize that God loves us. And God loves them, whoever they are, in the same way. Real recognizes real. Beloved recognizes beloved. Jersey swap!

Do you know who is the best at doing this? At least in my life, it was my mom. When I was about 10 years old, I was standing in our yard outside of what we called the breakfast room. I had just watched my mom wash the windows. There was snow on the ground and I decided it was a perfect time to throw a snowball at the window! When that snowball hit the just-washed window, my mom looked at me, the kindest, sweetest, most unselfish person I have ever met, in my mind a saint, and said, "You stupid jerk!" She never said stuff like that, but it definitely fit in this situation. Did this irreparably harm our relationship? Heck, no. Because Moms are the best at loving. They love us despite what we do because their love is deeper than our actions. They love us first. They recognize our beloved-ness and nothing can take that beloved-ness away, no matter how hard we try. This is the kind of love that Jesus is commanding us to have for each other. The love a Mom has for her children. The love that God the Father has for Jesus. The love that Jesus has for us.

This week, recognize your beloved-ness. Jesus says, "As the Father loves me, so I love you." Jesus says that to you! Sit with that. Feel it. Believe it. Then, remember that Jesus says that to every person you will encounter this week. Every single one. In each encounter you have with another person this week, with your family (even if some of them are stupid jerks!), with people at work or school, or in the store or on the road, remember you are beloved of God and so are they. You don't have to like everything they do to love as God loves, because God loves first. Let real recognize real. Let beloved recognize beloved. Jersey swap!

BIRTHDAY CARD CHANGE





IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT 2020 PARISH SHARE

During 2020, the Parish Share Program totaled more than \$70,000 for the three churches combined. However, yearly goals were not met and monies collected were used to supplement operating expenses throughout the year. Unfortunately, this is occurring at many churches, and the Diocese of Pittsburgh is also suffering financially. The Diocese has asked that our 2020 Parish Share Assessment be brought up-to-date. Saint Clare is blessed with savings accounts; one of which all three churches have money in is On Mission For the Church Alive! To support transparency and accountability in best fiscal practices, Saint Clare has petitioned the Diocese to amend case statements for all three churches' On Mission Deposit & Loan accounts held in savings by the Diocese. Once case statements are amended to include "debt payments for Parish Share," those monies can be withdrawn from the savings and applied to the 2020 Parish Share assessment.
