1.8 Financial report

John Cameron noted that the club has lost money for 2 years in a row and that is a disappointing result given the generous COVID subsidy that was received in this financial year. John Drayton replied that the travel lift refurbishment impacted the results and as Robyn Deverall noted the committee has endeavored to cut costs by cutting out the poorly supported Wednesday and Sunday night openings and there was no charge / income for the hardstand rental during the lock down period.

Neil Shaw asked if the club was satisfied that the covid subsidy application conditions were met. John Drayton responded that in accordance with advice received we fully complied with the covid subsidy conditions.

Dave Squire queried the travel lift expenses noted in the accounts and John Drayton advised that they included contractors working on the repair work. Dave Squire stated that having these figures combined makes subsequent years incomparable.

Vicky MacKay requested that Shayne O'Hagan provide a written explanation of the travel lift expenses.

Past Commodore Allan Davidson advised that the travel lift repair work was supposed to be capitalized and this was detailed in the strategic plan which did not appear to be followed by the current committee.

Dave Squire also queried the restaurant figures and was advised that the 2019 figures were only part of the year and that the 2020 figures reflected excessive wages which was a problem the committee were working on. Eleanor Barrett agreed that wages at 71% of turnover is excessive!

4.3 General business

Doug expressed concern that the communication to the members was below par. Examples were

Bar being closed to members downstairs for function without notice, treasurer not available at AGM is another example. Menno advised that the "Things from Thursday" publication is not being read by members and some dates such as the AGM are difficult to move.

Jan Barrett considered the advertising of the opening day was below par given the expense of the day and the club was paying for the "Beat girls" but no effort to ensure maximum participation.

Robyn Deverall said members who don't read "Things from Thursday" can only blame themselves for being poorly informed.

Dave Squire requested an update on yard configuration. Menno replied that the review by Marinco was completed and following receipt of this progress was interrupted by COVID shutdown. Subsequently the interruption to the normal trading activities of the club reduced the motivation to spend significant funds on progressing this aspect of the club structure without getting the restaurant and catering service functioning profitably. Our efforts to get surveying underway have not been successful yet.

Allan Struthers considered that the breast work is often occupied by commercial boats. Menno replied that there are two or three commercial boats that have a load or unload arrangement with the club.

John Cameron stated that commercial boats are not supposed to use the breast work and that could jeopardize the continuing lease of the land that the club operates under.

Menno advised that the commercial wharf under the railway bridge remains in a state of disrepair and there has been an arrangement to allow commercial boats to unload or load for \$ 50.00 a time but not to overnight. The rate is 3 years old.

John Drayton advised that the committee is reviewing all club charges including hall fees etc.

General discussion continued on this point including a motion to ban overnight stays at the breast work. The upshot of this discussion was that the club unanimously supports policing of the current unload and load policy. Over night stays for special requirements by arrangement only.

Robyn Deverall thanked the committee for the work they have put in over the year.

Menno thanked Ted Nation for his contribution to the committee and the club over his term

COMMODORE'S REPORT - MENNO OORTGIESEN

I am pleased to present my report for the year ended 31 July 2021.

First, I note the passing of the following members this year: John Muollo, Joan Mexted, Alex Lees.

I noted last year that with Covid, the 2020-21 year had been a challenging one and looked forward to things improving in the future. While they have to a certain extent, the impact of Covid has continued to disrupt our activities. Financially we are holding our ground.

There have been a number of staff changes this year with Colin retiring, we now have John McKenzie in the yard. Our house crew have gone through a few changes, we now have Cathy managing the functions and office environment.

Several social functions long in the planning have had to be deferred and we are still operating our club facilities at less than capacity, thanks to the ongoing challenges of a not yet post Covid environment.

Our moorings are an important asset for the moored craft owners in the Club. Utilisation has of course been down this year although the maintenance effort and cost continues with maintenance work being carried out to the best with our available resources.

Membership has gone up this year and with the reported increase in the sales of and preorders for trailer craft, we can expect to see a fresh influx of these members in the near future. Our facilities for trailer boats is sometimes challenged on good boating days, however, generally this aspect of the Club continues to run smoothly.

You will be aware of upcoming repairs to the Travel lift fingers. Following engineering advice, we have decided to repair rather than replace the fingers, which will buy us time to determine our future yard strategy. A less obvious impact of Covid has been a lack of progress in our plans to separate Yard and Trailer boat launching facilities. The next step in our plan, following the earlier Engineers report back is to survey the East yard to determine whether running the operation from there is feasible. Unfortunately, we have been unable to secure the services of a surveyor to complete this work, meaning we have made little progress. We are still hopeful of being able to progress this in the near future.

At times like these, the privilege of belonging to a Club like ours, both for the facilities we provide and importantly the ability to engage with other members with similar interests becomes very obvious. We have built an enviable reputation as a friendly Club and one which is a key part of our local community. If you don't attend Club nights, or support Club events, let me encourage you to do so in the coming year. You will be pleasantly surprised at the breadth of views and boating experience available through our almost 1,000 members, and by their willingness to help.

Finally, I would like to thank our staff and my Committee for the way they have handled another challenging year. Our sponsors have remained loyal to our Club in these unprecedented times, and we are grateful to them for this. Finally, to the many members who help out with the running of the Club, often unseen and generally unthanked, we appreciate your contribution.

REAR COMMODORE'S REPORT - YARD, MARTIN SCOTT

The Yard is performing well. The travel lift fingers needed repairs (which are ongoing) but we haven't experienced a lot of down time. Rob Paulin has done a great job in driving this project and overseeing that the job was done. Many thanks Rob for your efforts.

The grass area in front of the clubhouse has had the trees trimmed and there are plans for a proper mast rack to be installed.

The travel lift is in very good condition and is being serviced and maintained by All Crane Solutions on a regular basis. It has just passed its yearly inspection with no problems. The tyres have been of concern over the last 12 months but we have been able to acquire 4 re-treads from overseas and they have now arrived.

All the cradles now have all their chains replaced and certified, we have an engineering firm repairing arms where needed.

John our Travel lift operator and yard person joined last November has fitted in and doing a great job with making sure maintenance on the travel lift is up to date and the yard is operating smoothly. When the yard is not so busy John has been able to assist in the upgrade and repairs within the clubhouse.

John has re-arranged the east yard to try and accommodate more trailer parks for our growing trailer boat members. If he is on site he assists in the managing of the parking spaces.

I have been in this Rear Commodore position for 2 years and I am now standing aside. I hope that my replacement will enjoy the position as much as I have and that they get the same support from the Committee as I did.

BASIS OF REPORTING

Mana Cruising Club Incorporated has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not -For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

Mana Cruising Club Incorporated is registered for GST. All amounts are recorded exclusive of GST, except for Debtors and Creditors which are stated inclusive of GST

EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO BALANCE DATE

There were no events that have occurred after balance date that would have a material impact on the Performance Report. (Prior year - nil).

FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

All fixed assets are stated at historical cost except for;

- the Club House and Ground Improvements which are shown at 2005 indemnity value.
- the section of the Breastwork purchased from Mana Marina Paremata Ltd for \$1 and revalued at 31st July 04 to reflect fair value. The revaluation was based on the original construction cost in 1992 less depreciation.
- moorings Mana CC owns 4 moorings outright, a 50% share of 24 moorings with Pelorus BC, a 50% share of 26 moorings with Waikawa BC, and a 33.3% share of 22 moorings with Pelorus and Waikawa.

A value of \$3,422 each has been applied for our equivalent full ownership of 36.33 moorings

- the statement of financial performance, statement of financial position, statement of cash flows, statement of accounting policies and notes to the performance report in accordance with Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting Accrual (Not-For-Profit)

issued in New Zealand by the New Zealand Accounting Standards Board, and

(c) for such internal control as the Executive Committee determine is necessary to enable the preparation of a performance report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.
