Will proved 4 July 1799 Prerogative Court of Canterbury Wills of Hurstley Stoke-upon-Trent Do not where Hurstley is in

Thomas Heath was baptised on the 20th June 1734 Leek of Hallwater. Thomas married Elizabeth. Seemingly

(There is a possibility that Noah Heath is not this line of Thomas and Elizabeth).

Noah Heath the Sneyd Green Poet was baptised on the 30th October 1768 at Burslem. Noah's first marriage was to Mary Day on the 19th July 1789 at Newcastle-under-Lyme St Giles. Noah's second marriage was to Ann Lees on the 25th December 1803 Norton in the Moors.

Noah Heath was baptised on the 22nd March 1795 Burslem the son of Noah Heath and Mary Day. Noah's first marriage was to Ann Marsh on the 17th July 1815 at Norton in the Moors. Noah's second marriage was to Elizabeth Harris on the 27th July 1833 at Swansea Wales.

Thomas Heath was baptised on the 22nd January 1819 Swansea Wales and baptised on the 14th February 1819 at Saint Mary Goat Street Methodist Swansea. Seemingly Thomas marries Hannah Machin in 1844 at Doncaster Yorkshire. Thomas died in 1860 at Rotherham Yorkshire.

Nathan Heath the son of Nathan Heath and Sarah Clews married Ann Wright Married by licence purchased 20 June 1801 Stoke-on-Trent St Peter and Vincula from The Reverend Wm Fernyhough. Aged 21 or upwards of Burslem Parish.

Occupation Potter. Signed in own hand.

Nathan is mentioned on Andrew Heath's will proved 1799.

Nathan's occupation to around 1820 was a potter and then became a farmer in Sneyd Green until his death. Nathan was buried on the 21st October 1851 at Norton le Moors.

Thomas Heath died on the 24th December 1826 and was buried on the 26th December 1826 at Norton in the Moors. Cousin John Scragg listed on burial record.

William Heath was buried on the 24 September 1864 Norton Le Moors aged 58 years.

The will of William Heath late of Stockton Brook in the Parish of Stoke-on-Trent Engraver deceased who died 19 September 1864 at Sneyd Green in the Parish of Burslem. Was proved at Lichfield by the oaths of Ellen Heath of Sneyd Green aforesaid Spinster, and Henry Heath of Sneyd Green Commission Agent the Brother and the Reverend William Dunn Lamb of Cobridge Burslem aforesaid Clerk the Executors.

Effects under £3000.

Elizabeth Heath died in 1893 at Sneyd Green.

James Heath was baptised on the 15th January 1809 Hanley and was buried on the 23rd March 1814 Norton le Moors age 6 of Burslem.

Ellen Heath was buried on the 21st April 1890 Norton le Moors.

Anne Heath was baptised on the 9th April 1815 Hanley

Nathan Heath was baptised 23 May 1816 Burslem St John
Buried 30 July 1877 at Norton le Moors aged 61

13 October 1877 Administration of the effects of Nathan Heath late of the Sneyd Green in the Parish of Burslem in the county of Stafford farmer a Bachelor who died 26 July 1877 at Sneyd Green was granted at Lichfield to Elizabeth Heath of Sneyd Green Spinster the Sister and one of the next of Kin. Effects under £800.

Charles Heath was baptised on the 9th November 1817 at Burslem St John. Charles married Jane Turner on the 22nd April 1856 Newcastle upon Tyne. Charles died in 1896 at Sneyd Green.

Thomas Charles Heath son of Charles Heath and Mary Jackson on the 10th December 1884 at St Philips and St James Milton. also lived Stockton Brook Bagnall time of marriage a Farmer living Sneyd Green Cobridge.

Heath Thomas Charles of The Home Farm Keele died 9 November 1920. Probate

Nathan Heath was born on the 21st December 1885 the son of Thomas Charles Heath and Mary Jackson. Nathan married Nellie Amson. Nathan served in WW1 from Home Farm Keele Newcastle-under-Lyme Staffordshire Regiment number 85919 Royal Garrison Artillery aged 27.

Died 5 October 1963 of Yew Tree Farm Yarnfield near Stone Administration Chester 1 May to Peter Heath farmer £2318.

Thomas Charles Heath and Mary Jackson's other children are Ellen Heath, Charles Heath and William Heath.

Harold Fell Heath was born 1870 Hanley. Harold married Ida Mary Hanson in 1902 Newcastle upon Tyne. Harold Fell Heath of 7 Humbledon View Sunderland died 1st March 1925. Probate granted in Durham on the 30th May to Ida Mary Heath widow. Effects £2819 18s. 9d.

Children Margaret Mary and Harold Edward Fell Heath both were born at Durham Sunderland.

Prudence Meaykin born 1679 at Horton. Prudence married Hugh Walkinson on the 1st July 1697 at Horton St Michael.

Is this the Faithfull Meakin (Meaykin) baptized 29 May 1683 Horton, whom became the Reverend Faithfull Meakin

Is this the Faithfull Meakin whom died January 1753 Cheshire

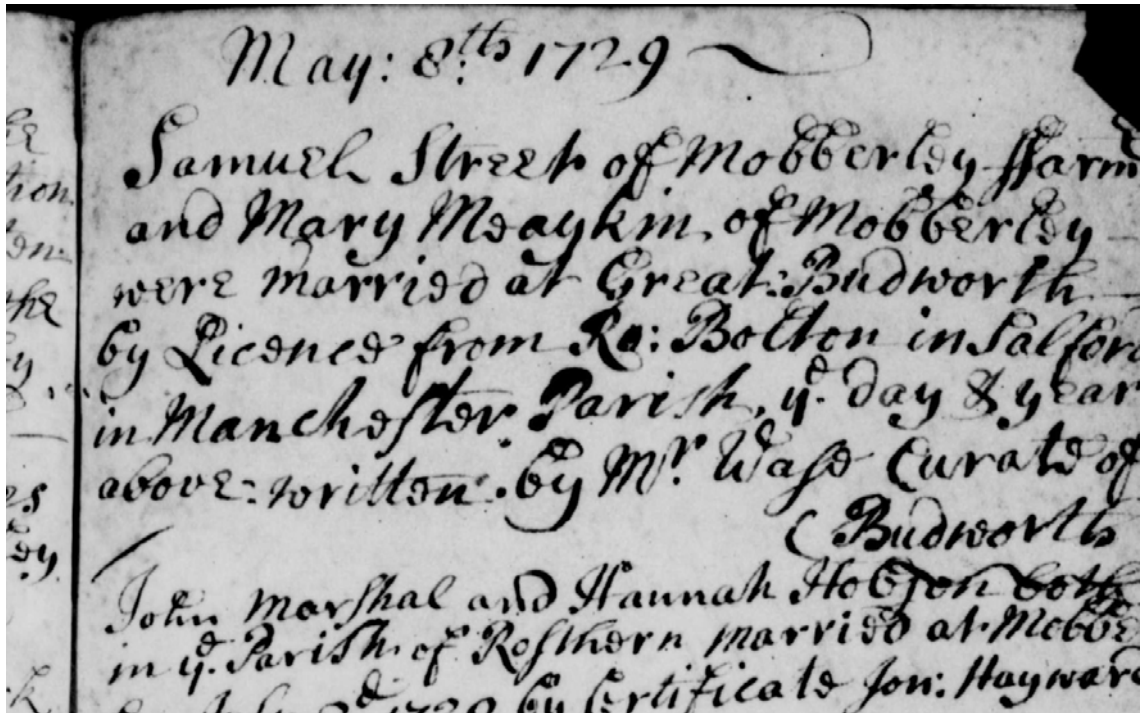

Thomas Street was born on the 28th November 1730 at Mobberley Cheshire the son of Samuel Street and Mary Meaykin. Thomas Meaykin Street died on the 19th January and was buried on the morning of the 20th January 1740/1 of Mobberley. Faithfull Street was baptised on the 26th February 1732/3 the son of Samuel Street and Mary Meaykin. Faithfull Street of Goostree Cheshire married Mary Heawood marriage record or Heywood on marriage banns, on the 18th April 1758 at Stockport St Mary Cheshire. Faithfull was buried on the 22nd June 1809 at Bowdon Cheshire of Sandiway Dunham Cheshire.

Hannah Street was baptised on the 18th February 1759 at Mobberley Cheshire the daughter of Faithfull Street and Mary Heawood. Hannah Street of Bowdon married William Shaw of Bollington Cheshire on the 13th July 1779 at Rostherne Cheshire.
