






Trail Brushing Crew 2019! We had 50 people show up on a gorgeous fall Saturday for our trail brushing on Saturday, October 19th.

# SNOWMOBILE SAFETY EDUCATION CLASS

#### December 14 & 15, 2019

The Bo-Boen Snowmobile Club's Snowmobile Safety Education Class will be held on Saturday and Sunday, December 14 & 15, 2019 at the St. Germain Community Center. Anyone 11 years of age or older is eligible to take the class and receive a safety education certificate, however, the certificate does not become valid until the child reaches 12 years of age. Pre-registration is required by calling Peggy Ausloos at (715) 542-3548 or online at gowild.wi.gov.

Beginning January 1, 2001, any person born on or after January 1, 1985 and who has reached the age of 12, must have completed and received a snowmobile safety certificate in order to operate a snowmobile in Wisconsin. The certificate must be carried while operating the snowmobile, and displayed to a law enforcement officer upon demand.

All students are required to obtain a Wisconsin DNR Customer ID# as part of the criteria to graduate from any Recreational Safety Class and provide that number to their instructor. Students can obtain a DNR Customer ID# from St. Germain Sport Marine during business hours or by calling 1-888-936-7463 between 7 AM and 10 PM. You can also visit a Wisconsin DNR Service Center during their regular scheduled hours. You will need to provide your social security number. For additional DNR Service Center hours and locations go to www. gowild.wi.gov and click on the "Get Started" tab.
