- Minimum resolution of 300 dpi and size of 2 inches x 3 inches. You may submit an uncropped, full-size version, and we will crop it for you. Please do not send pictures from a social media site such as Instagram or Facebook. These tend to be low resolution images which will print blurry. Please send the original electronic version.
- Saved as a .jpeg or .tif
- The picture is a portrait image (upright) vs. a landscape image (sideways)
- The picture does not depict violence, alcohol, drugs, or anything that would violate school rules such as a weapon.
