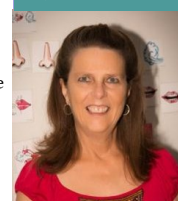

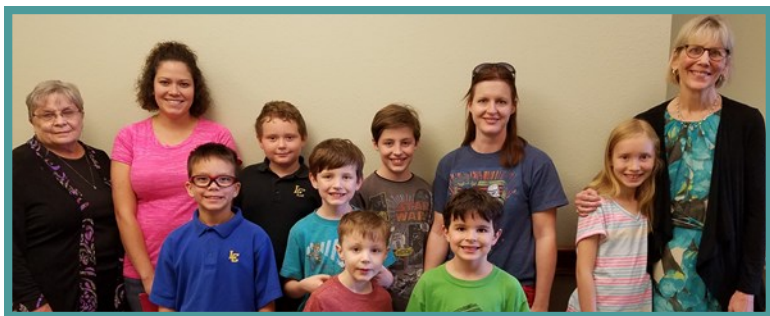

Colton Weaver won 1st place for his den and the grand prize for the entire pack at the Boy Scout Pinewood Derby held on January 28, 2017.



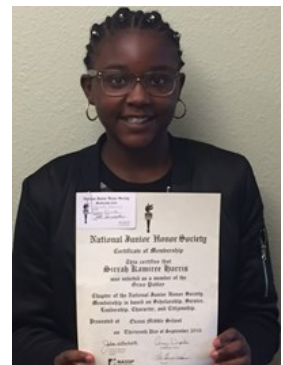
Rachel Denton made and entered several items in the Panhandle South Plains Fair. Rachel won a few ribbons. She also made this quilt.



Kristin Mitchell is in the Lubbock Youth Symphony Orchestra.



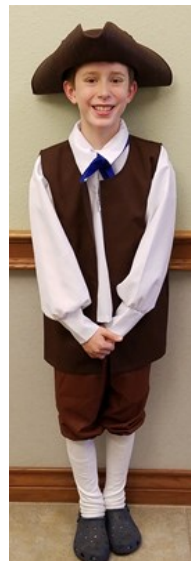
Emily and Kaitlynn Smith entered baked goods in the Panhandle South Plains Fair and each won a second place ribbon.

Braylee Bell placed 2nd at the New Home Science

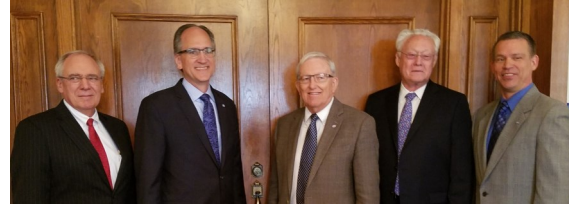
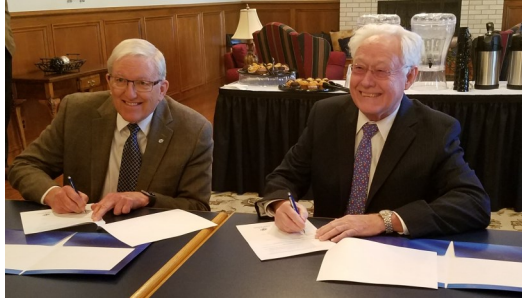
Fair which advanced her to the Regional Science Fair held at Texas Tech. At Tech, she received a 1st Place on the display board and a medal for the project.
