BUCK SHOTS

- Owners of the top record in the NBA at 22-9, the Milwaukee Bucks continue their season-long five-game road trip on Friday night with a matchup against the Brooklyn Nets. Friday's game is also the second of three consecutive games for Milwaukee against the other top four teams in the East, having already played against the Cavaliers (3rd) on Wednesday, with the Nets (4th) coming up tonight and a Christmas Day matchup against the Celtics (2nd) coming on Sunday.
- The Bucks and Nets are meeting for the second of four times this season, with the Bucks picking up a 110-99 win earlier this season in Milwaukee on Oct. 26. The win was Milwaukee's sixth in its last seven regular season games against Brooklyn. Under head coach Mike Budenholzer, the Bucks have won 10 of their 14 regular season contests against the Nets, which includes a 5-1 mark in games at Barclays Center.
- For just the fifth time in his career (reg. season and playoffs), Giannis Antetokounmpo has scored 40+ points in back-to-back games as he scored a season-high 45 points against the Cavaliers on Wednesday after scoring 42 points on Monday against the Pelicans. Antetokounmpo is now third in the NBA in scoring this season, averaging a career-high 31.6 points per game, in addition to ranking fifth in rebounding at 11.2 rebounds per game.
- Bucks first round draft pick MarJon Beauchamp has reached double figures in scoring in three of his last four games after putting up 11 points on Wednesday against the Cavaliers. Over his last four games, Beauchamp is averaging 11.8 points in 19.3 minutes per game, knocking down an average of 2.5 threes a game, while shooting 51.7% from the field and 45.5% from three (season avg: 6.5 ppg, 41.4 FG%, 35.9 3FG%).

MILWAUKEE BUCKS LAST THREE GAME RECAPS

Bucks at Cavaliers – Wednesday, Dec. 21 – Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse – Cleveland, Ohio

L, 106-114 – Giannis Antetokounmpo scored a season-high 45 points at Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse on Wednesday, but the Bucks couldn't finalize the comeback and fell 106-114 to the Cavaliers. Antetokounmpo and MarJon Beauchamp opened the scoring for the Bucks and sent them up 4-0. The Cavaliers took a 5-4 lead only a minute later and after three lead changes and ties, Cleveland pulled ahead for the final time. Despite being down 20+points, the Bucks scored 35 points in the third quarter, including an 11-5 run to end the frame. Milwaukee continued pushing into the fourth quarter, opening with an 8-2 run to cut the lead to 85-95 with 9:38 remaining. The bucks kept scoring and eventually cut the lead to eight points, the first single-digit lead since the first quarter, off of a fadeaway from Antetokounmpo. Pat Connaughton hit a three to cut the lead to five points, but the Cavs pushed it back to eight points. Antetokounmpo hit a layup to make it 106-112, but Cleveland managed to pull away and hold off the Bucks. In addition to his 45 points, Antetokounmpo led the team with 14 rebounds. Jrue Holiday also dished out eight assists. The Cavaliers were led by Donovan Mitchell with 36 points.

Bucks at Pelicans – Monday, Dec. 19 – Smoothie King Center – New Orleans, Louisiana

W, 128-119 – The Bucks stopped a Pelicans comeback to take a 128-119 victory at Smoothie King Center on Monday during the first game of their season-long five-game road trip. The Bucks led by five points at the beginning of the third quarter after a close first half battle, where Giannis Antetokounmpo scored 26 points. MarJon Beauchamp and Brook Lopez both hit threes early in the third quarter and started to build a lead for Milwaukee, but the Pelicans stayed within nine points or fewer for much of the quarter. A free throw from Pat Connaughton gave the Bucks a 93-83 lead with 3:19 remaining in the third quarter and they maintained the double-digit lead for the rest of the quarter. Milwaukee opened the final quarter on a 10-2 run to take a 110-92 lead, but New Orleans powered back with a 22-7 run of their own, cutting the Bucks' lead to just three points with 1:32 left in the game. With the clock winding down, Jrue Holiday hit a three-pointer that sent the Bucks up by six points and Lopez quickly followed with a layup that gave the Bucks a 122-114. The Bucks made all six of their free throw attempts in the final minute of play to prevent the comeback. Antetokounmpo finished with 42 points and 10 rebounds to lead the Bucks, while Jrue Holiday dished out 11 assists. Lopez also scored a season-high 30 points in the win. The Pelicans were led by Jonas Valanciunas with 37 points.

Bucks vs. Jazz – Saturday, Dec. 17 – Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, Wisconsin

W, 123-97 – Playing without Giannis Antetokounmpo and Khris Middleton, the Bucks returned home on Saturday, knocking off the Utah Jazz 123-97 at Fiserv Forum. After a relatively close first three quarters of play, Milwaukee entered the fourth quarter on top 92-83. It was in the fourth quarter where the Bucks pulled away, holding the Jazz to just 14 points on 31.8% shooting and no threes made. Meanwhile, Milwaukee shot 57.9% from the field in the quarter, making seven threes. Bucks rookie MarJon Beauchamp led the way in the fourth, scoring 11 points. Ultimately, it was an 11-0 run to start the fourth quarter that put the Bucks ahead for good. After going up by 20, Milwaukee never led by less than 20 the rest of the way, pushing its lead to as many as 32 points near the end of the game. Bobby Portis Jr. led the Bucks on Saturday, scoring 22 points and 14 rebounds while Jrue Holiday added 21 points and eight assists. Beauchamp finished the game with 18 points. The Jazz were led by Lauri Markkanen and Malik Beasley who each scored 18 points.

W, 110-99 – The Bucks scored 67 points in the second half to defeat Brooklyn 110-99 at Fiserv Forum on Wednesday for their third straight win. The Bucks started the second half down by 12 points but began to close to gap with a layup from Giannis Antetokounmpo. Antetokounmpo hit two free throws and a reverse layup with 5:40 left in the third to force the game's first tie (64-64) since the first quarter. The Bucks earned their first lead of the second half off of a layup from Bobby Portis Jr., taking a 72-70 lead with 3:28 remaining in the third quarter. Milwaukee never trailed from this point, despite three ties in the first two minutes of the fourth quarter. A step back three from Jrue Holiday gave the Bucks a 93-83 lead with 5:16 left in the game. A final three-point make from Wesley Matthews solidified the Bucks' comeback win. After scoring only nine points in the first half, Antetokounmpo finished the game with 43 points to lead the team. He also led the team with 14 rebounds and five assists. Brook Lopez finished with six blocks to help the Bucks get the win. Kevin Durant led the Nets with 33 points.

Tying their season-high 22 lead changes, the Bucks battled but maintained control even when behind. Milwaukee entered the second half with a 69-59 lead, but Boston forced the lead down to one point in the third quarter and kept it within six points until the end of the game. A driving layup from Marcus Smart gave the Celtics a 118-121 lead with 2:27 remaining, but Boston didn't score from that point as a three-pointer from Bobby Portis Jr. set up a 7-0 game-ending run. Giannis Antetokounmpo and Jrue Holiday each scored 29 points to lead the Bucks, while Khris Middleton dished out nine assists. The Celtics were led by Marcus Smart who scored 29 points.

HEAD COACH MIKE BUDENHOLZER



Mike Budenholzer is in his fifth season as head coach of the Milwaukee Bucks, having led the Bucks to an NBA Championship in 2021, the most wins in the NBA and four playoff appearances in his first four seasons with the franchise.

After taking over as head coach in 2018, Budenholzer has guided the Bucks to a 213-96 (.689) regular season record and a 38-22 (.633) mark in the postseason, which combined, are the most wins in the NBA over the past four seasons.

In addition to winning the NBA Championship in 2021 – the franchise's second title and first in 50 years –

Budenholzer has led the Bucks to a top three finish in the Eastern Conference all four seasons, including the top record in the NBA in each of his first two seasons with the team, and two trips to the Eastern Conference Finals (2019, 2021).

Budenholzer has found success in Milwaukee by turning the Bucks into an elite offensive and defensive team. In his first four seasons with the team, the Bucks led the NBA in scoring three times, including the 2020-21 season when they averaged a franchise record 120.1 points per game. Defensively, Milwaukee has led the league in defensive rating twice under Budenholzer and has finished in the top 10 in three of his four seasons.

Budenholzer reached his 100th and 200th wins with the Bucks faster than any coach in franchise history and begins the 2022-23 season in third place on the Bucks' all-time regular season wins list and second on the all-time playoff wins list. He currently leads the franchise in both regular season and playoff win percentage. Budenholzer has also earned Eastern Conference Coach of the Month honors four times as coach of the Bucks (Jan. '19, Feb. '19, Dec. '19, Jan. '20) and was selected to coach Team Giannis in the 2019 NBA All-Star Game.

Entering his 10th season as an NBA head coach, Budenholzer is a three-time winner of Coach of the Year, earning the honor in the 2014-15, 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons. In 2014-15 with the Atlanta Hawks, Budenholzer won the Red Auerbach Trophy as the NBA's Coach of the Year and in 2018-19 with the Bucks, he again won the Red Auerbach Trophy as the league's Coach of the Year, in addition to being named the Michael H. Goldberg National Basketball Coaches Association Coach of the Year, which is voted on annually by the NBA's head coaches. Budenholzer was then named a co-recipient of the Michael H. Goldberg National Basketball Coaches Association Coach of the Year, along with Oklahoma City's Billy Donovan, following the 2019-20 season. The 2014-15 and 2018-19 seasons were Budenholzer's first with the Hawks and Bucks, respectively, where he earned Coach of the Year honors after leading both teams to 60 wins and appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals.

Budenholzer became the 16th head coach in Bucks history on May 17, 2018, bringing more than 20 years of NBA coaching experience to Milwaukee, having been part of coaching staffs that won four NBA Championships. He came to the Bucks from Atlanta where he compiled a 213-197 (.520) record in his first five seasons as a head coach with the Hawks from 2013-18. He was named NBA Coach of the Year following the 2014-15 season after he led the Hawks to a franchise-high 60 wins and an appearance in the Eastern Conference Finals. Atlanta made the playoffs in four of Budenholzer's five seasons with the team.

Prior to joining the Hawks, Budenholzer spent the previous 19 seasons with the San Antonio Spurs, including the final 17 seasons as an assistant coach, where he was part of one of the most successful eras in NBA history. As an assistant coach with the Spurs from 1996-2013, Budenholzer helped lead San Antonio to a league-best 908-438 (.675) record and NBA Championships in 1999, 2003, 2005 and 2007. Budenholzer spent his first two seasons with the Spurs as a video coordinator before becoming an assistant coach in 1996. He also served as the team's Summer League head coach on numerous occasions and was an advance scout for Team USA for the 2004 Olympics.

A native of Holbrook, Arizona, Budenholzer is a 1993 graduate of Pomona College where he received a bachelor's degree in politics, philosophy and economics and was a four-year letterman in both basketball and golf. Following college, Budenholzer played professionally in Denmark for the Vejle Basketball Klub, averaging a team-high 27.5 points per game during the 1993-94 season, while getting his start in coaching, serving as the head coach for two different teams in the Vejle system.
