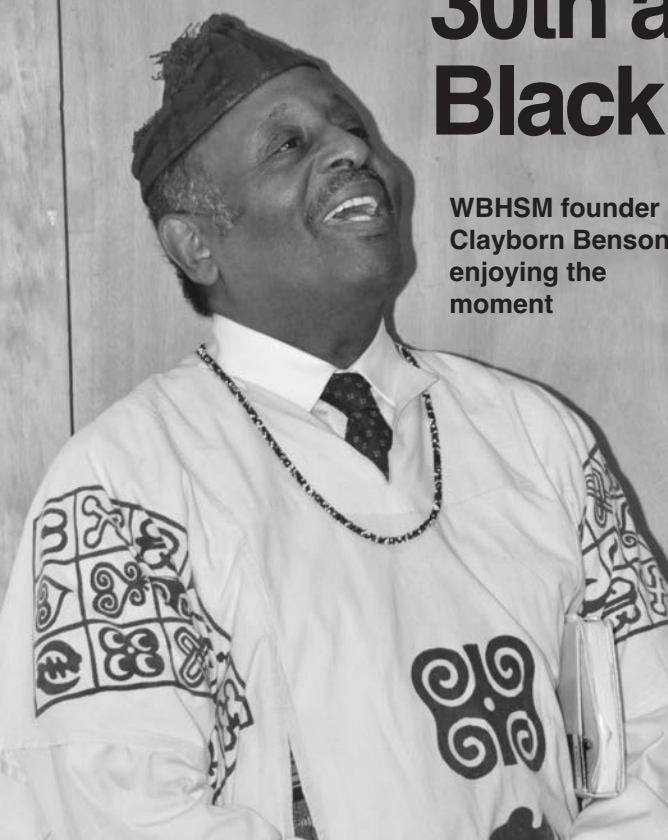

Center St. The keynote speaker was Bill Taylor, influential TMJ4 news anchor/reporter for 30 years from 1972-2002. It was announced during the gala that Jamila Benson, the daughter of the museum's founder, Clayborn Benson will be the museum's new executive director. 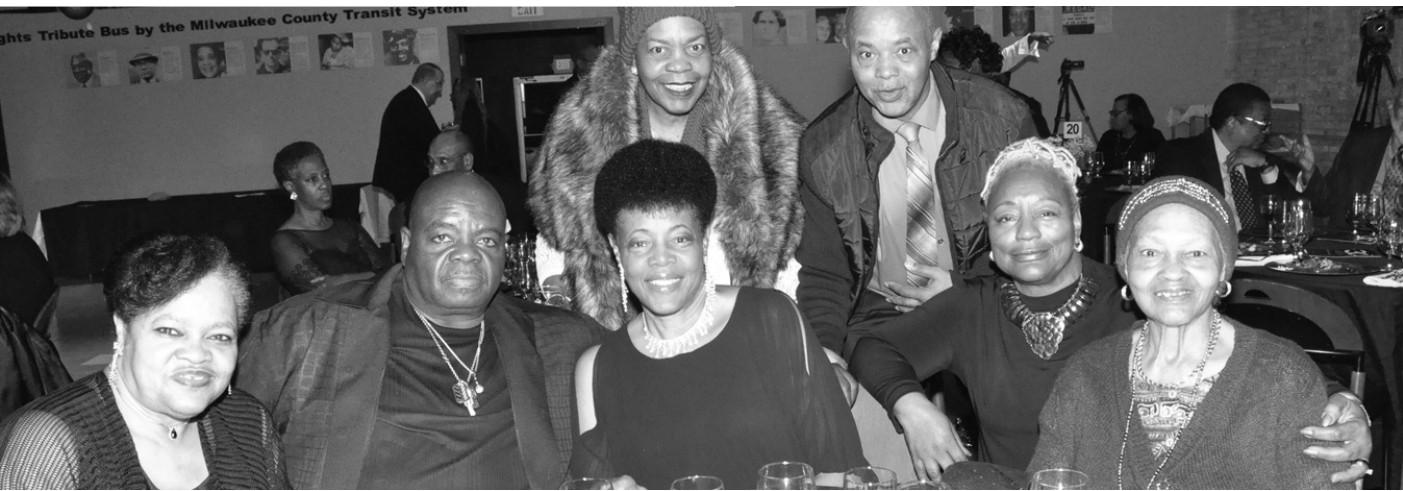

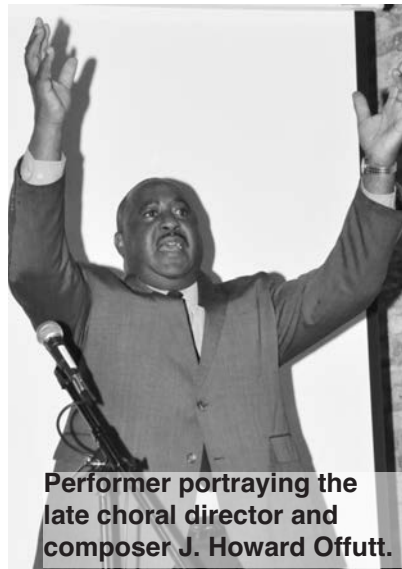
