

The Wisconsin Black Historical Society/Museum (WBHSM) held its 30th annual gala recently. The event was held in the historic Bernice Lindsey Hall of the WBHSM, located at 2620 W. Center St. The keynote speaker was Bill Taylor, influential TMJ4 news anchor/reporter for 30 years from 1972-2002. It was announced during the gala that Jamila Benson, the daughter of the museum's founder, Clayborn Benson will be the museum's new executive director. 


