Please note: Two test papers cannot be combined as evidence of English Language Proficiency.

All domestic and international applicants are required to meet the English language skills Registration Standard as outlined by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA) at <a href="https://www.nursingmidwiferyboard.gov.au/">https://www.nursingmidwiferyboard.gov.au/</a> and are required to demonstrate English language proficiency either by providing a written declaration that English is their primary language or evidence that they have achieved the minimum English language test results.

All applicants must demonstrate their English Language competency in one of the following ways: PRIMARY LANGUAGE PATHWAY:

- a. English is their primary language; and
- b. They have attended and satisfactorily completed at least six years of primary and secondary education taught and assessed solely in English in a recognised country\*, including at least two years between years 7 and 12.
