UAE International Travel Information

Passport and Visas:

- **Personal travel of 30 days or less:** A U.S. citizen with a regular passport may obtain a no fee visitor visa upon arrival.
- **Stays longer than 30 days:** Visitors on a 30-day visa may request a visa extension, which is at the discretion of immigration officials. Anyone planning to work or study in the UAE must obtain the appropriate visa.
- U.S. passports must have 6 months validity after date of arrival.

COVID-19 Protocol:

Please note that COVID-19 regulations are ever-changing. Please check with your airline, <u>UAE official government COVID-19 guidelines</u>, <u>U.S. Embassy & Consulate in the UAE – COVID-19 Information</u>, and <u>Travel.State.Gov</u>, prior to your departure.

Effective February 26, 2022, passengers traveling to Dubai from all countries (GCC included) must fulfill one of the below requirements:

- 1. Present a valid vaccination certificate(s) reflecting that the passenger is fully vaccinated with a vaccine approved by the WHO or the United Arab Emirates (UAE), and includes a QR code; or
- 2. Present a valid Negative Covid-19 Test certificate that should be based on a molecular diagnostic test intended for the qualitative detection of nucleic acid for SARS-COV-2 viral RNA, that is issued within 48 hours from the time of sample collection and issued by an approved health service provider, with a QR code; or
- 3. Present a valid medical certificate issued by the relevant authorities that the passenger has recovered from Coronavirus SARS Covid-19 within a period of one (1) month from the date of recovery to the date of arrival, with a QR code
- Travelers should check with the airline for the latest information on COVID testing. Depending on vaccination status and the country from which one arrives; post-arrival COVID testing may also be required and regulations vary. The latest information is available from official sources.
- Dubai International Airport has devoted a section of the Terminal Three Departures Hall to COVID-19 testing. They conduct COVID-19 RT PCR tests, with results returning in three (3) to six (6) hours. The Dubai International Airport recommends that departing travelers arrive five (5) to six (6) hours before departure if they wish to take the test at the airport.
- All vaccines which have been listed by the WHO are approved for entry to the UAE.

• If traveling to Abu Dhabi, tourists may likely be required to sign up for the green pass through the UAE vaccination app, Al Hosn. You will be required to take a PCR test once every two weeks while in Abu Dhabi. As of March 1, 2022, carrying a printed copy of your negative PCR test results and proof of vaccination card is also accepted to enter indoor facilities. As of January 2022, those traveling to Abu Dhabi are required to have a booster COVID-19 shot.




