Flicking the Pages of Cricket is a fascinating look at one of cricket's smaller collectable artefacts – the cricket flicker book. These pocket-sized books, which are viewed rather than read, document the techniques of leading players across cricket's eras. Commonly referred to as "thumb theatre", they are not only books but an early form of pre-cinema animation.

Paul has charted the progress of these unique cricket books over their 70-year history, starting with their first release in England in 1930 and proceeding to the creation of new formats of these books in India and Australia. *Flicking the Pages of Cricket* is an in-depth look at cricket flicker books and their contribution to the evolving story of cricket as a global and multiformat game. The book is a paperback comprising 52 pages, with over 40 photos.
