

Fall/Winter/Spring Season runs October 1-June 21 Open Enrollment - Choose your start date and continue for as long as you wish. All students are invited to participate in the Annual Student Art Exhibition in the Spring.

Adult Studio Drawing & Oil Painting

Join our fun group of artists who are improving their drawing and painting skills while enjoying the camaraderie of creating fabulous works of art together. Whether you are a beginner student or advanced artist, learning how to use the traditional art master methods will help you achieve a more realistic, lifelike drawing and painting. Everyone, regardless of level or ability can learn these techniques! You will learn how to see and correct shapes, proportions, edges, shadows, lights and midtone values. Develop painting application techniques, understand color theory and mixing paint.

Students may work from life or photo images of landscapes, still life, people or portrait — whatever is of interest as you build skills and confidence to take on more ambitious projects, or if you prefer, continue drawing and painting at a fun and relaxed pace. All students receive individual instruction tailored to their personal goals and speed. Students may draw or paint but are strongly encouraged to do both!

Plein Air Paint-Out & Studio Paint-In (If rain)



Learn to paint an impressionism painting en plein air (in the open air) as we paint a landscape from life, at a local site. Composition design and traditional art master painting techniques will be taught, including how to mix colors of nature in landscapes as seen in morning light. On rainy days we will work in the airconditioned studio and paint from photo images of landscapes or seascapes. Each week will offer a different location.

Every child has his or her learning style, ability and art focus interest. Students taking classes at Rosemarie Morelli Art School learn how to **see better** so they understand how to **draw and paint better!** All classes provide a mix of projects from Programs 1 & 2 below depending on your child's interest, skill level and ability. There will always be a project ready to challenge and meet the needs of the student. Enjoying the creative process is most important while your child develops art skills. Students work on their own projects at their own speed. Each class provides individual instruction including group art activities to improve student's understanding of art. All students are welcome to participate in the Spring Student Art Show.

Program 1: Beginner/Intermediate Levels All Media Art - Creative Painting, Drawing, Illustration, Print-Making and Multi-Media

This is a "fun art projects for everyone" approach! Students choose from a variety of media to create artworks that interest them while learning the core basics of art fundamentals for better drawing, painting, and "seeing". Instruction is given in techniques for Pen & Ink Illustration and Cartooning; Charcoal, Graphite and Color Pencil Drawing: Pastels drawing and painting: Oil, Acrylic & Watercolor Painting; and Multi-Media creations. Block Printing, Plaster Relief Sculpture and Mural Panel Painting are special optional projects that will be made available each season. A stock photo image library and still-life objects are available to help inspire as students flow from



project to project, selecting subjects from landscapes, seascapes, still life, portrait, animals, architecture, fantasy creatures, fashion textile design and whatever else interests them.

Program 2: Advanced Levels Classical Drawing & Painting

For students seeking a more realistic likeness in their artwork, this class will nurture your child's talents with step-by-step methods and guided instruction

Instruction on how to render light, shadows and midtones along with teaching the tools for correcting shapes are emphasized during each project. Whether it be animals, nature, landscapes. seascapes, still life objects, architectural scenes or people, students choose to work from subjects that interest them as they learn how to render textures, smooth and reflective surfaces, transparent objects. water and much more.



Drawings are done in choices of charcoal. graphite, color pencil, pen & ink and pastels. Painters work in their choice of oils, acrylics or watercolor.

Open Studio Art Camp is a "student's choice" class offered each week as an alternative to any of the core focus theme weeks. Student's get to create according to their interests, selecting from any project offered at the studio throughout the year: Drawing, Painting, Cartooning, Science Fiction/Fantasy Illustration, Block Printing, Multi-Media, Mosaic Textile Painting, Color Pencil Illustrations, Mural Panel Painting and Plaster Relief Sculpture Carving. Art media include Acrylics, Oil & Watercolors Paints, Pastels, Color Pencil, Graphite, Pen & Ink, and multi-media. The sky is the limit in regards to subject - students can set up a still life or have access to a large stock photo library for reference in landscapes, seascapes, architecture, animals, nature, people, portrait...and more! Individual and group instruction given to develop art skills.

Cartooning & Fantasy Art - All ages.

Explore the art of exaggeration as students learn to cartoon, illustrate and morph human characters, animals, ordinary objects, robots or whimsical creatures. Then, design and illustrate background scenes or storyboard in pen & inks, color inks, watercolors, color pencils and more to complete your film still, or comic strip storyboard.
