## WEEKLY MESSAGE by Samantha Wesley

I seem to say this every year around this time, "where has the summer gone?!?" I cannot believe that August is beginning at the end of this week. Before we get into back to school this and that, kick off events and so forth, I want to share with you an event we had in our green space (which is the grassy area above the Family Life Center parking lot between Martin Street and Darrow Road) called Slide-A-Rama!

On an early Saturday morning in July, I was driving to church and as I passed the Walkertown Community Park there it was in our green space...a 13 foot tall inflatable water slide attached to a 30 foot slip-n-slide which ended into a little pool. It was an amazing sight! I knew this slide would place many smiles on many faces as the fun was going to begin in a few hours. I had scheduled this Slide-A-Rama day many months ago for our kids and their families, to come and have some water fun, fellowship and lunch together. As the canopy tents, lawn chairs and people started to arrive, in the distance I could hear the kids..."WOW!" "OH MY!" and then, "Ms. Sam why are we having this today?" my response, "Why not?!"

I received the job of holding a water hose with a spray nozzle to keep a portion of the slide wet, which gave me one of the best seats in the house to talk and laugh with the kids as on the opposite side they were lined up in order to climb the inflatable stairs to embark on their journey of fun. I then got to watch them slide down and laugh and say "AGAIN!!!".

The kids and adults that participated didn't care how long the line was they just knew this was for them and they could have a day of water fun with their friends at church. In my first weeks here a few years ago, I was walking around getting acquainted and when I saw the green space, I knew this area would be a great place to hold many events. My vision was cast to the Children's Council to use this space for advertising as well as hosting events. As people drive by and see the fun, I wanted them to say "that looks like fun, wonder what else Morris Chapel is up to?" By way of water, concerts, VBS, kick ball and so much more in the green space, we are showing by example the love we have for Jesus. And yes, people from the community have stopped and asked me on occasion as I have been in the parking lot, "What's going on?".

All events and programs the Children's Council and myself always ask "How can (fill in the blank) grow the family of God?" This mission statement of Morris Chapel blends well with our Children's Ministry theme of *Play Together. Learn Together. Grow Together.* The kids learn that one day it will be their turn to pass faith on to their kids, just as their parents are doing right now for them. My heart is singing with joy!!!
