Attention 6th grade parents!

It's time to get your child immunized for middle school!

All incoming 7th graders are required to have updated immunizations prior to starting school. Please visit your doctor's office or the Bear River Health Department to get these completed. Please fax, mail, email or bring to South Cache a copy of your completed immunizations by:

To attend 7th grade, a student must have written proof of receiving the following immunizations:

- ◆ Tdap
- ◆ 2 Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- ◆ 3 Hepatitis B
- ◆ 2 Varicella (chickenpox)
- ◆ 1 Meningococcal (Only Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine given after 10 years of age is acceptable for 7th grade school entry)
- ◆ 4 Polio
- ◆ 2 Hepatitis A
- ◆ 5 DTaP/DT

*Please note: All 7th grade students need a Tdap booster and Meningococcal vaccine. If you have been up-to-date on immunizations to this point, two vaccines are required for 7th grade entry.

*If you plan to claim an exemption to immunizations for your child, you must complete a new immunization exemption for 7th grade. Please visit www.immunize.utah.gov and complete the "Immunization Education Module (exemptions)". When completed, please email the certificate to brittnie.sautter@ccsdut.org
