ver the past several months, alumni and friends of the graduate programs in health administration have received information about a very special project for the Department of Health Services Administration.

One of our favorite professors, Dr. Howard Houser, is planning to retire within the next few years after more than 30 years of preparing young people for careers in health administration and for life itself. As a way of honoring Dr. Houser's commitment to excellence and passion for teaching and mentoring students, we are raising money to establish the Howard Houser Endowed Professorship in Health Services Administration at UAB. Once endowed, the Houser Professorship will serve as a lasting tribute to Dr. Houser's legacy as a professor and will provide a tool for the Department of Health Services Administration to attract or retain an outstanding faculty member to fill the very big shoes that Dr. Houser will leave behind.

We have challenged the MSHA classes to raise at least \$10,000 per class, which would easily help provide the funds necessary to reach the \$500,000 funding level required to establish an endowed professorship.
