3. QUALIFICATIONS: In accordance with § 2 of the U.S. Muay Thai Open Official Rules

ELIGIBILITY: International amateur athletes ages eight (8) years and up are eligible to participate in the USMTO.

An **Amateur is defined as:** An athlete who has **never competed for any money prize or a prize that exceeds the value of thirty-five dollars**, *or* teaches, pursues, or assists in the practice of boxing or

mixed martial arts as a means of obtaining a livelihood or financial gain.

4. EXPERIENCE

CLASS:

**DEFINITION:** Bout: Participation an any event or contest, sanctioned or otherwise, in which people compete in Muay Thai,

Mixed Martial Arts (MMA), kickboxing, San Shou, or boxing

**NOVICE CLASS (C):** Athletes who have competed in zero (0) to three (3) bouts

I NTERMEDIATE CLASS (B): Athletes who have competed in four (4) to nine (9) bouts

**OPEN CLASS (A):** Athletes who have competed in ten (10) or more bouts

## 5. CLASSES AND DIVISIONS:

### TEAM MEMBERS

**DEFINITION:** Coach: A person who has registered with the USMTO and is involved in instructing the Competitor

during competition

**TEAM OFFICIALS:** There is no limit to the number of team officials, however, only registered officials will have access to

the competition area.

ATHLETE LIMIT: There is no limit to the number of athletes in each team

COACH LIMIT: There is no limit to the number of coaches who may attend; however, the number of coaches allowed

ringside is limited to two (2).

Last Call - Registration APRIL 26, 2018 - \$250.00
