Coaches Corner

Some reminders for coaches about locking up fields and equipment:

- After the last game of the day at the complex, be sure to: lock the Jo Box, lock the dugouts, and check to ensure the snack shack, bathroom, and equipment room are locked.
- When first unlocking the dugouts at the MLL Complex, hang the lock on the fence and close the lock. That way it won't disappear during the game. We've had several locks disappear between the beginning of the first game and the end of the last game
- Be sure to lock up the Jo Boxes at all fields and the complex.
- If you are the last evening game at the complex, be sure to turn off the field lights and put the posts up at the entrance to the gravel parking lot.

Base Paths: Please be sure to rake the dirt towards the middle of the base path, not toward the grass.
