Floutie

MODES

Modes are scale patterns with different half- and whole-step combinations. An easy way to hear them is to use a C tuning on your harp, and play as indicated below.

Start on the indicated note and play up one octave.

Ionian mode - start on C (this is the major scale)



Dorian mode - start on D (this sounds like minor but has a raised 6th)



Phrygian mode- start on E (this sounds like minor but has a lowered 2nd)



Lydian - start on F (this sounds like major but has a raised 4th)



Mixolydian - start on G (this sounds like major but has a lowered 7th)



Aeolian - start on A (this is the natural minor scale)



Locrian - start on B (this just sounds different!)

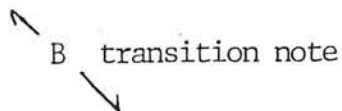
