A Note from Our Music Director Greg Santa Croce

"I Am the Bread of Life" and "Drinking God Straight"

During the month of August, we've frequently heard passages at Mass from the sixth chapter of John - the Bread of Life Discourse. It seems like a great time to sing and discuss what I consider a modern American Catholic classic: "I Am the Bread of Life," composed in 1966 by Sr. Suzanne Toolan, RSM. The text is



striking in that it doesn't rhyme or fit into a poetic meter. Each verse has its own rhythm. Contrast this with a text like "O God Beyond All Praising" that we sang on August 22 to see what I mean. Each line of "I Am the Bread of Life" is lifted directly, without paraphrasing, from either John 6 – the aforementioned Bread of Life discourse – or John 11 – the story of the resurrection of Lazarus.

So why sing a prose text? The late Fr. Columba Kelly, a Benedictine monk and sacred music scholar, compared singing prose to "drinking God straight." His thoughts and the composer's instincts are in line with what the fathers of the Second Vatican Council thought about hymn texts when they wrote in *Sacrosanctum Concilium*: "texts intended to be sung ... should be drawn chiefly from holy scripture and liturgical sources." Sr. Toolan is not unique in this text setting approach. Other well-known examples from about the same time include "Keep in Mind" by Lucien Deiss, "This is the Feast" by Richard Hillert, and "Be Not Afraid" by Bob Dufford.

I would argue that when we sing the same words that Jesus said, as we do in "I Am the Bread of Life," we experience His presence in a special way. Paired with the opportunity to receive Jesus' true self in Holy Communion, this song enhances our participation in the sacrament of unity.

Adult Choir

If you enjoy singing at Mass and would like to share a bit more of your time and talent, consider joining Adult Choir. This group sings at all Sunday and Holy Day Masses from September to June.
