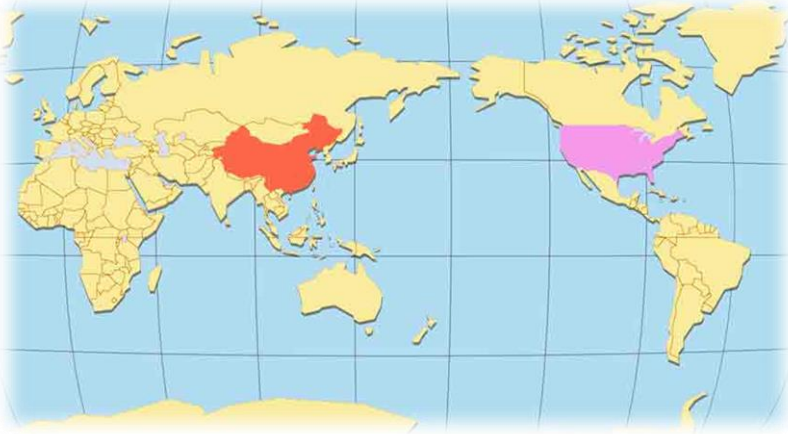

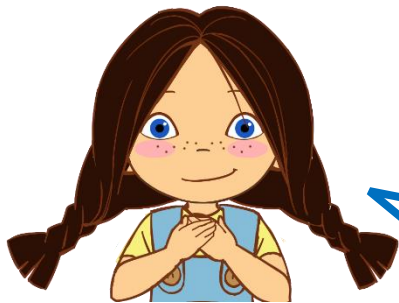


Beijing is the **capital** of China. A **capital** is the city where the government is. The government is next to Tiananmen Square .

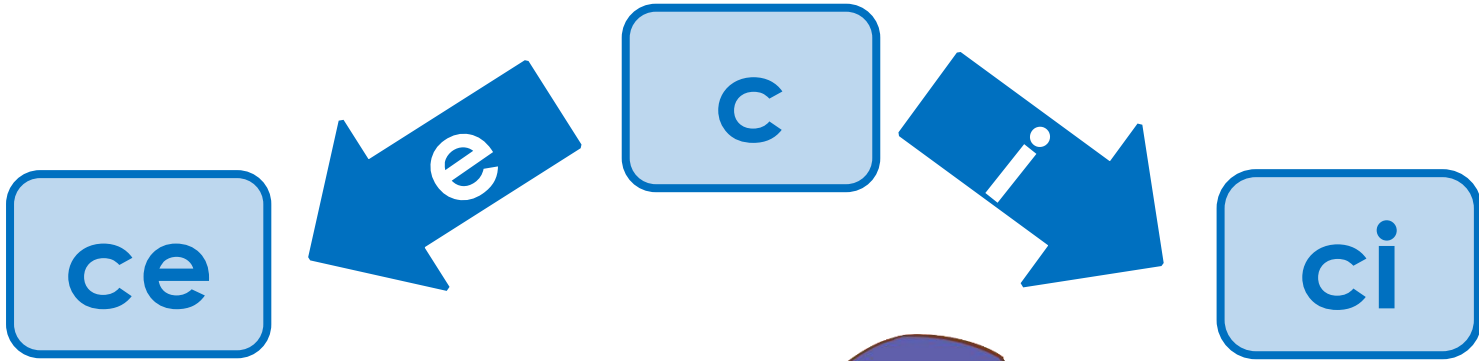

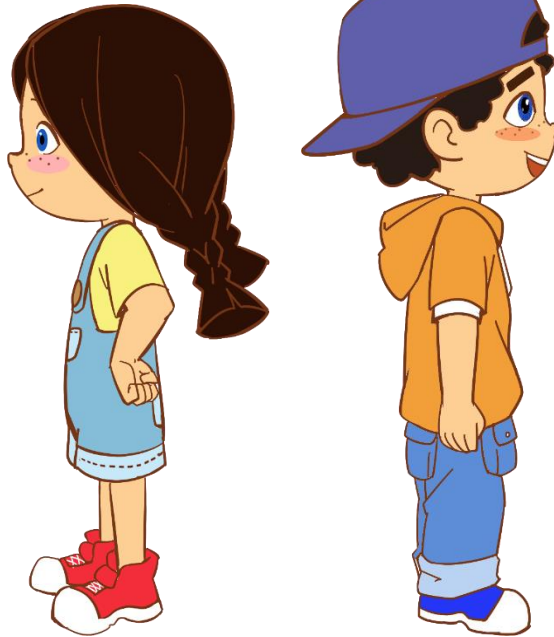

Tips: T tells S: "When the letter 'c' is followed by letter 'e' or 'i,' 'c' often makes the same sound as the letter 's.' This sound is called the soft 'c' sound." First, T makes the "s" sound, S repeats.
