

- After the Civil War the city was founded as a freedman's district named Deep Elm for its location on Elm Street, but the locals' pronunciation (Deep Ellum) became the generally accepted name.
- At its peak in the 1920's, the area was known for its thriving businesses and dominance in the jazz scene - mostly run by African American entrepreneurs.
- After four decades of decline that began in the 1940's (due to bad city planning), Deep Ellum resurged as a haven for artists and a home for the punk scene.
- Now Deep Ellum features: novelty shops, restaurants, and intimate art galleries for daytime visitors, and a bright and thriving nightlife that rings with music and people early into the morning.




