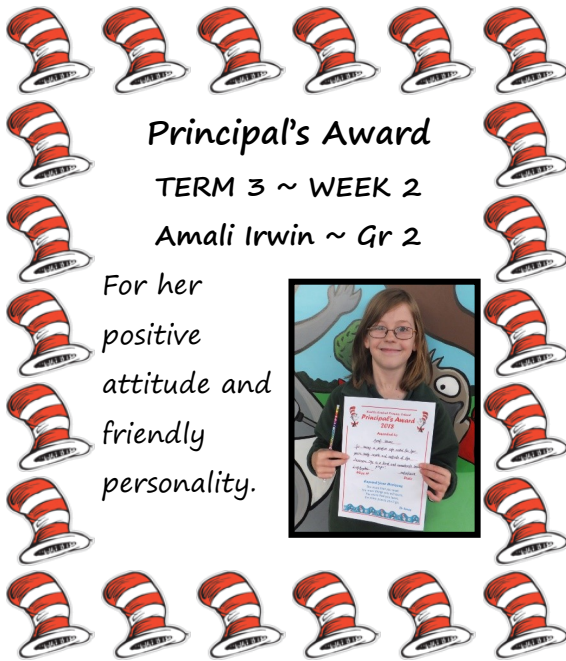

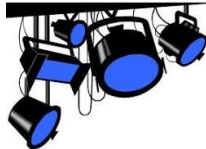

Round 18 Wrap

On Friday night, the **Tigers** ran out 54 point winners over the **Saints**. **Ross** finished with 33 touches for the **Saints** with 30 disposals to **Martin** for the **Tiges**. This was a healthy percentage boost for the **Tigers** who remain on top of the ladder.

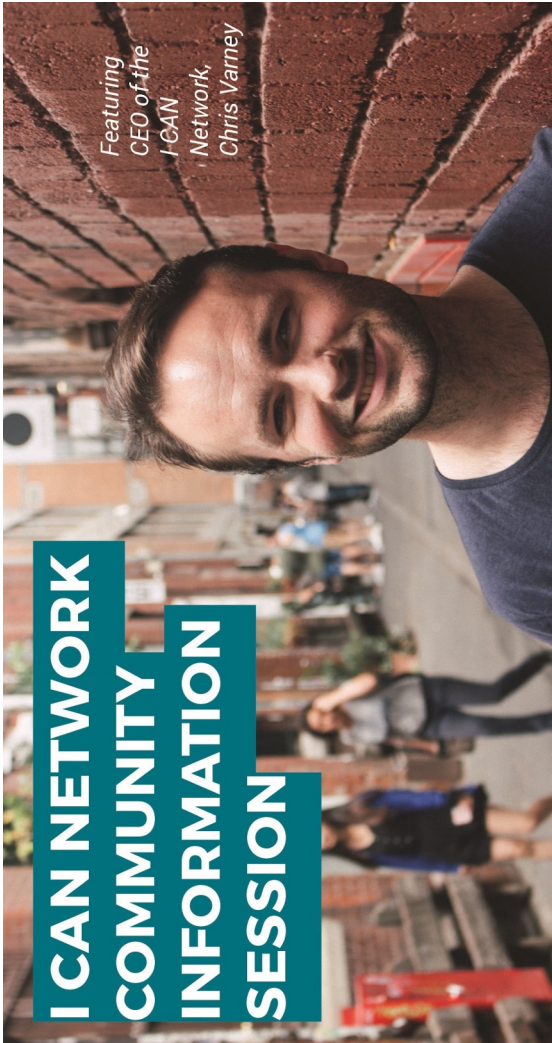
