I. AGE ELIGIBILITY

Contestant must not be more than 18 years old on November 21, 2018.

VIOLIN

ELIMINATION ROUND:

1st movement of a concerto (refer to list of concertos for the Final Round)

- 2. 1st and 2nd movements of any of the following:

- A. Contestants who perform works not included in the submitted Repertoire List, without the written permission of the Chairperson of the Strings Competition shall be disqualified.
- B. The Sonata and Concerto must be by different composers.
- C. The Concerto must be performed from memory and without scores.
- D. The Sonata and Filipino piece may be read but a memorized performance is preferred.
- E. The applicant shall be responsible for his/her own accompanist.
