When using the word <u>college</u> in direct reference to Elizabethtown, the C should be uppercase.

DR., ACADEMIC TITLES, SCPS instructors

In all College *achievements*, the title of Dr. will precede the names of all professors (who have a doctorate – check the online College directory if unsure). A description of his or her academic title follows. Example: *Dr. John Smith, professor of biology, ...* On additional references, use only the professor's last name. Otherwise it is not used. Never use Ph.D.

SCPS instructors are referred to as **affiliated** faculty **not adjunct**.
