Organizational History

Alpha Portland Cement Company, one of the largest companies in the portland cement industry, was organized on April 8, 1895 by a group of Philadelphia area businessmen. On April 10, 1895, a charter was granted to the new company by the State of New Jersey. Alpha's first principal officers were: George E. Bartol, President; Richard L. Austin, Treasurer; and G. Walter Holloway, Secretary. In the same year, the newly organized Alpha Portland Cement Company acquired the property of the Whitaker Cement Company at Bonneville, NJ, now Alpha, NJ. In 1901, the company moved its general offices from Philadelphia to Alpha, NJ and established its corporate offices in the Drake Building in Easton, PA. Alpha changed its incorporation from New Jersey to Pennsylvania in 1902. The company reorganized in 1910.

During the early years of its existence, the business grew rapidly. Alpha acquired other cement companies in quick succession beginning with the purchase of the Martins Creek Portland Cement Company, Martins Creek, PA in 1908; Cement Manufacturing Company in New Jersey in 1909; Buckhorn Portland Cement Company at Manheim, West Virginia (1909); and Catskill Portland Cement Company, Catskill, New York (1909). Later purchases included mills of the Thomas Millen Company, Jamesville, NY (1917); LaSalle Cement Company, LaSalle, Illinois (1920); Ironton Portland Cement Company, Ironton, Ohio (1920); Burt Portland Cement Company, Bellevue, Michigan (1920); Continental Portland Cement Company, Continental, Missouri (1922); and the Phoenix Portland Cement Co., Birmingham, Alabama (1928). By the late 1920s, Alpha operated ten cement mills located at strategic distribution points in ten different states.

The company began liquidating its cement plants in the 1950s. In 1964, Alpha closed its last plant at the Martins Creek facility. In 1977, the Alpha Portland Cement Company reorganized and changed its name to Alpha Portland Industries with executive offices in Roslyn, NY. The company severed all ties to the cement industry when it closed its cement and aggregates division in 1982. Later in 1985, Alpha Portland Industries changed its name to Slattery Group, Inc.

Scope and Content (11.25 linear feet – 9 record boxes)

Company records (1895-1984) contain business and legal files. They include minutes of Board of Directors and Stockholders meetings. correspondence, committee reports, stock listings, drawings of plant properties, company mergers, trade-mark registrations, by-laws, patents, and service contracts. The earliest records in the collection document the founding of the company, its incorporation, and early mergers with other cement companies. Records also include bound volumes of minutes and payroll ledgers of cement companies acquired by Alpha Portland Cement Company. Additions to the collection include tax files and financial activities of the company in the 1970s.

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Provenance

The Alpha Portland Cement Company gave its records to the Easton Public Library, Easton, PA during the 1980s. The National Canal Museum acquired the records from the Easton Public Library around 1998.
