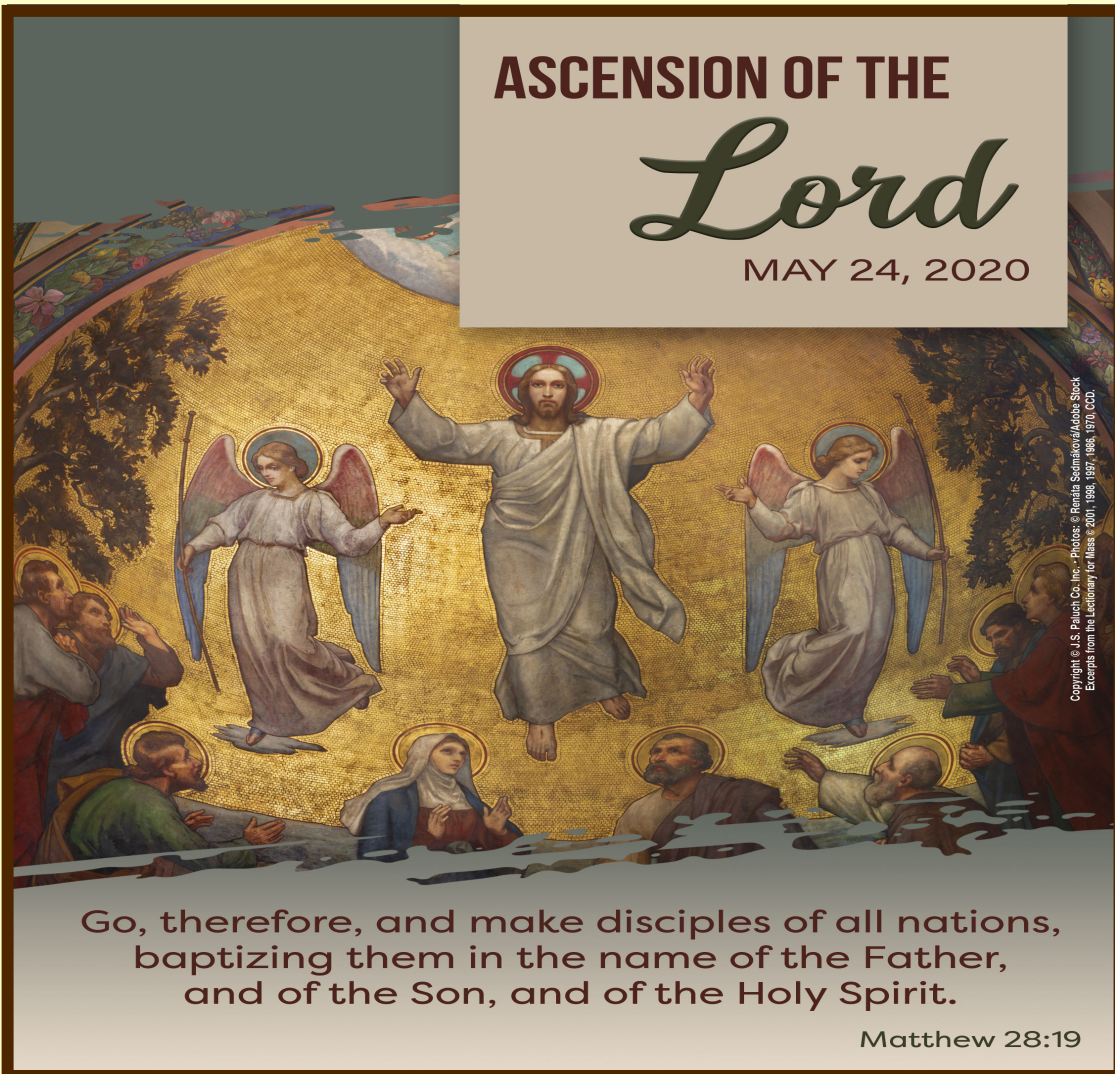

“PUSHED” OUT ON MISSION

There is a delightful character in the original Dr. Dolittle Tales called the “Pushmi-Pullyu.” It is a beast with two identical halves, with a head at each end. No matter which direction the beast walks, one end is the “push me” and the other is the “pull you.” Today’s feast is a bit like that in the life of the church. In the book of the Acts of the Apostles, it is the ascension of Christ that calls for the Holy Spirit, which consequently sends or “pushes” the church out on its mission. This is the message that we hear from the angels today as they tell the friends of Jesus not to look up into the clouds, but to get busy. It is the message of Jesus himself in Matthew’s Gospel, as he sends them out to baptize. He also tells them, “I am with you always, until the end of the age” (Matthew 28:20). And it is this message, confident in faith that Jesus has ascended to shouts of joy, that “pulls” us along to our final destiny. The life of the faithful disciple, sent into the world on mission, will one day know the same risen, ascended glory.

ST. MATTHEW PARISH UPDATE AS OF MAY 18, 2020

1. **OFFICE HOURS:** Open: **M-F 9 am to 3 pm.** and **9 am to 12 pm on Saturdays.**
2. **CHURCH BUILDING AND ADORATION:** Our Church is now open for Adoration under expanded hours without having a limit of 10 persons: M-F 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.; Saturdays 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Sundays from 2:30 to 6 p.m. Up until 7 p.m. we will keep both the entrance near the Adoration Chapel and the one in the Sacred Heart Foyer open; after 7 p.m. only the Adoration Chapel entrance will be open. Contact Michael Robles at 210-870-7612 if you are under 65 years of age and can commit to being there for one hour per week.
3. **MASSES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC REOPENED ON TUESDAY, MAY 19th, 2020.**
 - a. Public Masses with limited occupancy of our church began on Tuesday, May 19th. We will continue to have taped Sunday Masses available for viewing up to that date and beyond that date on our parish website: www.stmatts.org and Parish Facebook Page. We began with our daily Masses on Tuesday, May 19th except for the 8:15 a.m. Mass which will resume on June 1st. We will have the usual 6 a.m.; 12:05 and 6 p.m. daily Masses and the 8:15 a.m. Mass only on Saturday mornings for the time being. On Saturday May 23rd, we began with our first weekend Mass at 5:30 p.m. and continued with all regularly scheduled weekend Masses. Also, the Spanish Mass has permanently been moved to from 12:45 p.m. to 1 p.m. to allow for more time between that and the 11 a.m. Mass.
 - b. The dispensation for attending Mass in person has been indefinitely extended, so you may freely choose not to come to Mass in person during this time if doing so for safety and health reasons. We are reminded to suggest that those 65 and older or who have compromised health conditions are encouraged not to come at this time. Also, those who have the COVID-19 virus, those who have been exposed to someone with it within two weeks, those who are sick, have a fever or are coughing should also not come.
 - c. Parishioners must wear a facial covering in the church and only remove it when receiving communion. We know it is uncomfortable to wear but it is required.
 - d. Parishioners must be seated six feet apart from each other except for those living in the same household or belonging to the same family unit.
 - e. For daily Masses, you may enter the church from two places: the Sacred Heart Foyer (up to 7 p.m.) and the Adoration Chapel at any time the church is open for adoration. For weekend Masses, the church doors will be locked and not opened until about 20 minutes before Mass begins. The only entrance will be the Adoration Chapel entrance. Follow the cones along the two sidewalks when waiting to enter Mass to ensure distancing. For weekend Masses, you must follow the usher's instructions for seating. Beginning at Holden's Grove side moving towards the Chapel Side we will begin seating persons in the front row, then the third row, then the fifth, row etc.
 - f. We will offer overflow in the McDonald Family Center for the Sat. 5:30 p.m.; Sun. 9:15 a.m. and 6 p.m. Masses. The overflow from the 11 a.m. Mass will be the 11:15 a.m. Mass in the Athletic Center.
 - g. Communion will be brought to you when attending a weekend Mass but you will need to come up to receive communion for the daily Masses. For daily Masses, only one person should enter the communion line at a time, alternating from one side to the other for those aisles that have persons coming from two sides.
 - h. For weekend Masses only, when exiting the church, you will be dismissed from the back row to the front row when attending a weekend Mass. At daily Masses, you may exit at your own pace being mindful of keeping the six-foot distance from one another. Since you may be asked to exit the church in a different location from where you entered, if you are handicapped and the exit you are guided to leave

includes stairs, you can remain in your seats until everyone has exited, and then you will be allowed to exit by the Adoration Chapel area.

- i. We need volunteers to create sanitizing teams for the weekday Masses; a professional crew will sanitize after during the weekend. Please contact Danny Padron at 210-478-5005 if you can volunteer to help; we encourage those under 65 to help.
- 4. SACRAMENTS AND LITURGIES:** As of May 19th, all liturgies, including funerals and weddings, can accommodate about one fourth of our church's occupancy, which is approximately 250 persons. Regarding private baptisms, the number of persons invited must be smaller than 25 persons since the baptisms occur in the Main Foyer; e-mail Deacon Oscar at deaconoscar@stmatts.org for more information regarding baptisms. The Sacrament of Penance will resume during scheduled times on Wednesday, May 20th. For the time being, Reconciliation will take place in the McDonald Family Center. Fr. Dennis and Fr. Duncan will continue to anoint by appointment. We will also resume the Group Anointing of the Sick liturgies on the First Friday after the 12:05 p.m. Mass and on the Second Sunday now at 2:30 p.m. instead of 2:00 p.m. due to the Spanish Mass moving from 12:45 to 1 p.m. When you are attending the Friday Anointing Ceremony, just remain in your seat, wherever you were seated in the church, and a priest will go to you to anoint you. For those coming on the Second Sunday, wait until the Spanish Mass has been released and then find a seat in the center section of the church, maintaining the six-foot distancing.
- 5. UPCOMING CONFIRMATION, FIRST COMMUNIONS:** The Archbishop has delegated pastors and parochial vicars to be able to preside at Confirmation. We will be providing dates soon. Group First Communions will be rescheduled soon.
- 6. ST. VINCENT DE PAUL:** Their new office hours are 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Tuesdays thru Saturdays. They are accepting donations of food but still not of clothing at this time.
- 7. SCHOOL:** Our school continues to practice distance learning. The 8th Grade Graduation Mass will be rescheduled to a date this summer, possibly June 20th in the new Athletic Center.
- 8. MEETINGS:** We encourage groups to continue to meet by electronic means. Meetings will not be scheduled in our facilities until sometime this summer.
- 9. WEB PAGE:** Please visit: www.stmatts.org for the latest updates.
- 10. DONATIONS:** We are grateful for all who have continued to donate through mail, walk-in drop offs during office hours, or online. It is also possible to donate on a smart phone via text at: 555888 then type in "stmatts". Call Nanette at 210-478-5015 in our office if you need help with the process of setting up online giving.
- 11. FESTIVAL RAFFLE:** The festival raffle has been cancelled. If you have your tickets, you may recycle them now. If you turned in festival tickets and monies to us, we have not deposited checks but have been holding these donations in a safe place. Please call or leave a voice message with our parish secretary Kay at 210-478-5003. Instruct her as to how you want to handle the ticket sale monies you had sent to us.
- 12. PRAYERS NEEDED:** Please continue to pray for the virus' diminishment, for remedies and vaccinations, for the protection of medical personnel, and for those who have been affected by this virus.

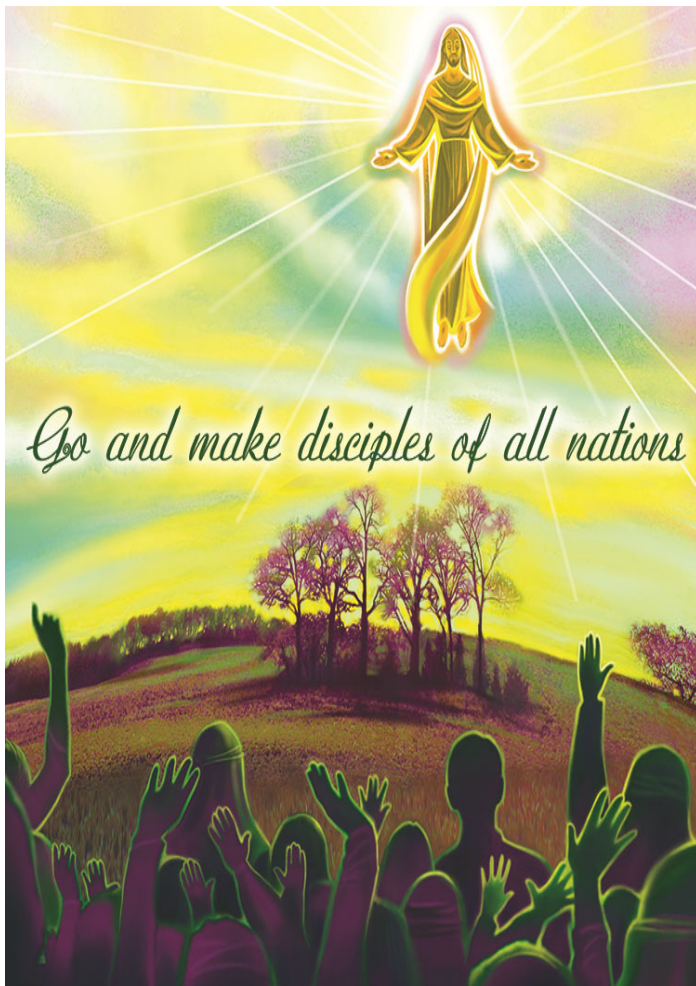
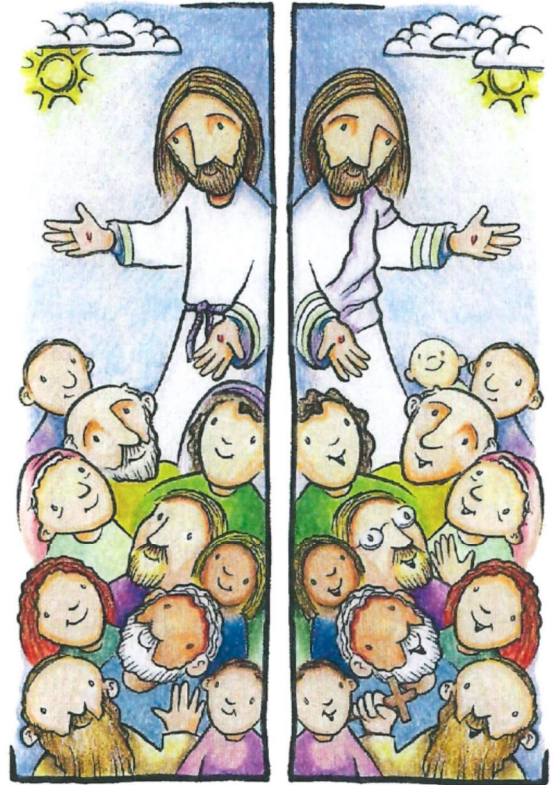
The two mirror images of Jesus' Ascension might look similar, but they aren't exactly alike. Still Jesus' message is the same. Here is what he said and did:
