**Home, Sweet Home**

Tigers live in amazingly diverse **habitats**. They roam Asia's forests, grasslands, and swamps. These habitats may appear to have very little in common. But they all share three characteristics. They have plenty of trees or tall grasses for the tiger to take cover in. They have lots of **prey**. And they all have water to drink.

The various subspecies of tigers have developed special **adaptations** that allow them to survive in their habitats. Siberian tigers, for instance, live in the birch forests of Russia. It is cold and snowy there. These tigers have long, thick fur that keeps them warm. Sumatran tigers live in the wet rain forests of Indonesia. They have only small amounts of white fur compared with other tigers. Too much white would make them stand out as they move around in green rain forests. Bengal tigers are adapted to hot, dry regions.

Later that morning, Louise was watching her dad and brother pan for gold. She had expected it to be fun and exciting. But after coming to California, she had learned that it was hard, boring work. Worst of all, they hadn't found a single bit of gold all morning.

"I'm going for a walk in the woods," Louise announced.

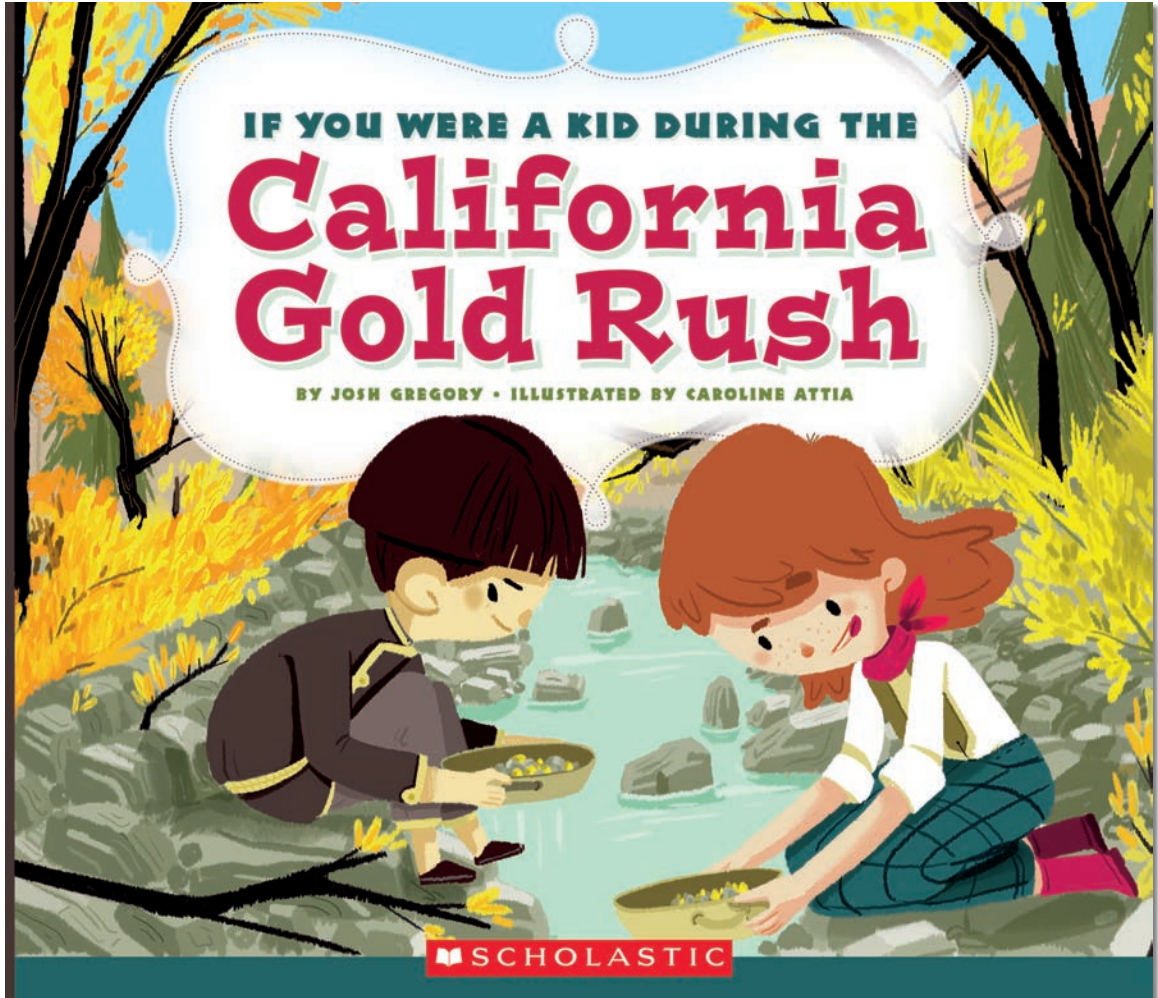
"Sure, sure," her dad mumbled, without looking up from his work.

"Be sure you're back by dinnertime."

**TOOLS OF THE TRADE**  
Prospectors used many tools and techniques to collect gold. The simplest way was called panning. A miner would collect water, gravel, and silt from a river or creek in a pan. He would then swirl the pan so the water and other materials would spill over the sides. That would leave the heavier gold at the bottom. A miner might repeat this process up to 50 times each day. And he might only get a little bit of gold. Another common method involved setting up a box by the river or creek. It would be filled with water and materials. Then it was rocked back and forth to separate out the gold.

Miners used pickaxes to break apart rocks and soil as they worked.

**Celebrate!**

Everyone loves a holiday, and we have some fun ones in Russia. New Year's Day and Christmas are my favorites. They are only a week apart, so it's a whirlwind of fun. Most people in Russia are Orthodox Christians. We celebrate the New Year first. At New Year's, Grandfather Frost visits. He's our version of Santa Claus. With him is the Snow Maiden. She brings lots of gifts!

For Orthodox Christians, Christmas is on January 7. We usually go to church on that day and visit family and friends.

**Maslenitsa (Pancake Week):** This is celebrated seven weeks before Easter. We feast on blini (thin pancakes) and avoid meat. The blini symbolize the sun.

**Russia Day:** This day celebrates the end of the Soviet Union and the beginning of modern-day Russia.

**Velikie Luki International Balloon Meet:** This week-long event includes a competition among some of our top balloon pilots.

**Knowledge Day:** Families celebrate the beginning of the school year by bringing their teachers flowers.

**Make Blini**

**Ingredients:**  
2 eggs, 1 tablespoon sugar,  
1 teaspoon salt, 1/2 cup flour, 2 cups milk, 1 tablespoon vegetable oil,  
1 tablespoon butter

**Directions:**

- Mix the eggs, sugar, and salt in a bowl.
- Sift in the flour and stir in the milk and oil. Mix until smooth and thin.
- Heat a lightly oiled frying pan over medium heat.
- Pour 2 tablespoons of the batter into the pan. Spread the batter evenly around the pan.
- Cook until the edges look crisp and the center is dry. Then flip with a spatula and cook for another minute.
- Remove from the pan. Continue making more blini until all the batter is used.
- Stack the blini, add a little butter in between each one, and enjoy!

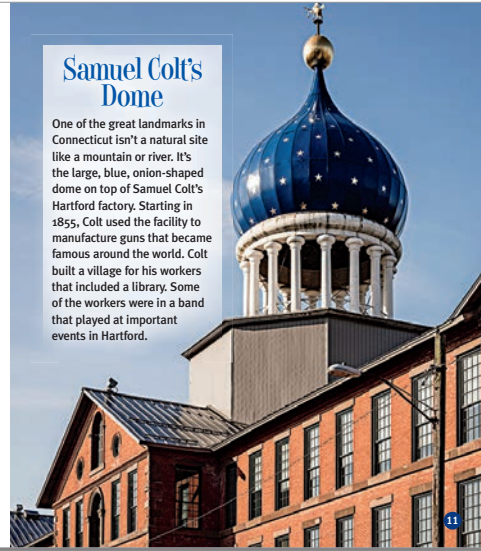


This map shows where the higher (orange and red) and lower (green) areas are in Connecticut.

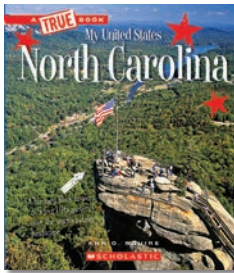

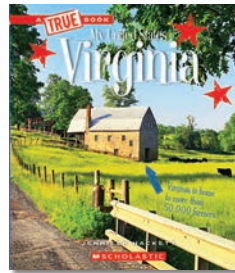
### Samuel Colt's Dome

**Layers of the Temperate Rain Forest**  
In the western area of the park lies the Hoh Rain Forest. There, some of the trees are more than 200 feet (61 m) tall. They include western hemlock and Douglas fir. Sitka spruces also grow here. The trunks of these trees can measure up to 60 feet (18 m) around. In the shadier areas beneath these towering treetops are vine maple, sword fern, and vanilla leaf. Far below is the forest floor. The dense collection of vines, ferns, and leaves above keeps most of the sunlight from reaching the floor. It is dark and damp, and mosses and fungi, such as mushrooms, grow here.

The Hoh Rain Forest was once part of a huge rain forest region that stretched from Alaska to California.

**Canopy**  
This is the top layer of treetops, which receives the most sunlight.

**Understory**  
Shade-loving plants flourish here, where the treetops of the canopy block some of the sun.

**Forest Floor**  
Mosses and fungi flourish in the dark dampness of the rain forest's bottom layer.

**Albania's Biggest Cities**

The largest city in Albania by population is the nation's capital, Tirana, with roughly 175,000 people. Durres (Durrës) is the second most populous city in Albania, with about 122,000 residents. It is located about midway on the nation's western coast and is the largest of all port cities. It is also one of the country's oldest cities, having been founded in the seventh century BCE. In recent days, gang battles make it economically vital to the nation. To repair areas, the government has invested millions into fixing up the city, which in turn has attracted more tourists, more professionals, and more foreign investment.

Elbasan (Elbasan) is the next most populous city, home to just over 100,000 people. It sits almost dead center in the country, along the shores of the Tiberian River. It began as a trading post along one of the best routes.
