  - Both reviewers and authors will be anonymized by removing names, institution lists, and acknowledgement sections.

#### Reasons to publish in *The Planetary Science Journal*

- Open access: All articles published in the PSJ are free to read and reuse under a CC-BY license. This means everyone everywhere can easily access your research when they need it.
- **Society owned:** The PSJ is owned by the American Astronomical Society, a non-profit professional society for astronomers, and editorial policy is set by the DPS. The journal is run by scientists, for scientists.
- **Fast publication:** We are committed to providing you with a fast, professional service to ensure rapid peer review and publication.
- Scope: The PSJ is dedicated to publishing articles that constitute significant new research
  that is directly relevant to planetary science, including observational results, theoretical
  insights, modeling, laboratory studies, instrumentation, or field studies.
- **Two Reviewers:** The PSJ will honor the legacy in Planetary Sciences of providing more feedback to authors by generally sending the manuscript to two reviewers.
- **Dual Anonymous Review:** The PSJ is dedicated to eliminating biases and allowing authors and reviewers to focus on the manuscript as written. We are therefore introducing dual anonymous peer review as the standard practice for all submissions to the journal. Both reviewers and authors will be anonymized by removing names, institution lists, and acknowledgement sections. Authors and reviewers can choose to sign their manuscript or review should they wish their identity to be known.

# Publication charges

- Special pricing is available for the first 100 articles accepted for publication in the PSJ: half off our regular gold-open-access rates.
- Members of the AAS who renew (or join) during the Society's annual renewal drive from early September through December are eligible to receive a 15% discount the following year on their share of the author charges for one paper published in an AAS journal, i.e., The Astronomical Journal, The Astrophysical Journal, Letters, or Supplement, or The Planetary Science Journal.
- The pricing structure for Gold Open Access manuscripts, including all *PSJ* articles, is \$61 for word quanta and \$53 for digital quanta. The charge rates are current for year 2020.
- Quanta include 350 words/quanta, individual figures and tables, and figure sets (digital quanta)
