Following this I have collated most of the questions that have already appeared in the first four sittings of the Edexcel Foundation GCSE for topics 1 to 5 (the rest will follow). Each topic is on a separate sheet as they may be useful for revision sessions, lesson starters or homework. I have also saved in the Essentials Tab of JustMaths Online (00 – Summer 19 – The last few lessons.)

I intend to use this information for some breakfast / revision worksheets targeted at high frequency 1 (and sometimes 2) mark questions to give students some confidence and much-needed practice before their exams.
