You need to register an account *using an Atlantic Health computer.*

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Go to uptodate.com using a hospital computer.



2. Click on **Register**



3. Fill out the registration form

4. Uptodate will send you an email → “Important UpToDate registration information”

5. Go to your app store (iPhone or iPad) or Play Store (Android devices). Search and download UpToDate app.



6. You will then be able to access UptoDate with the mobile app instead of going through the web.

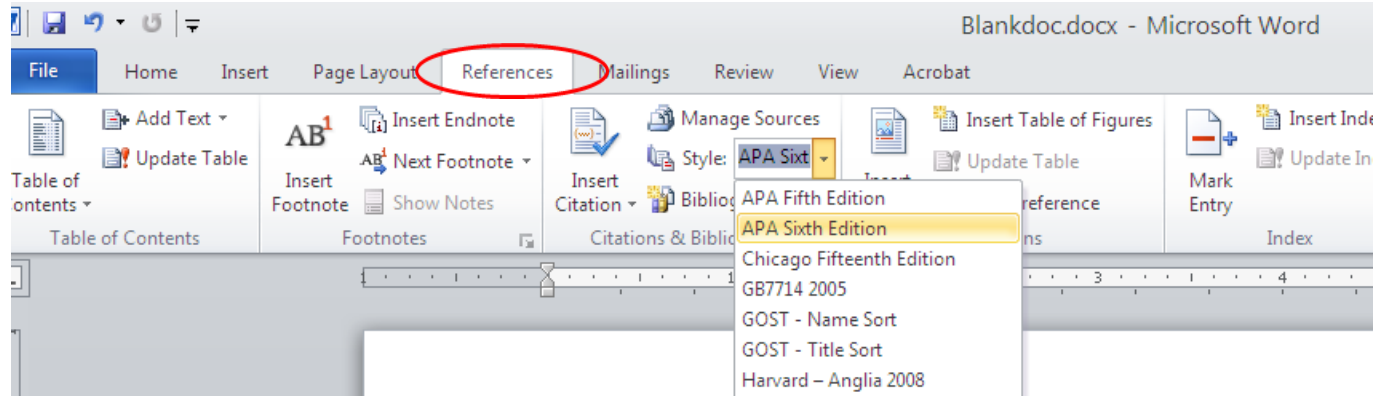

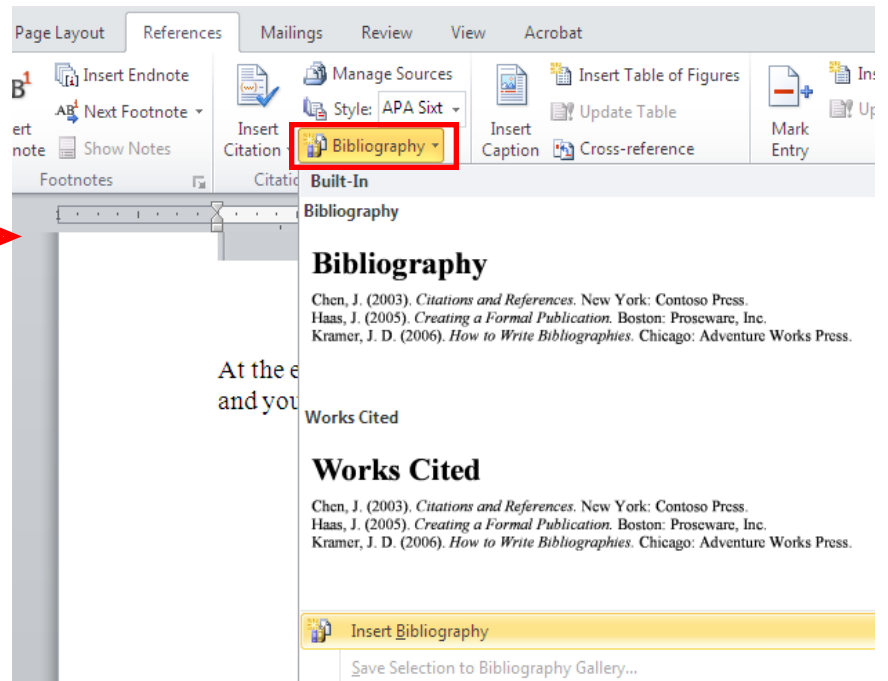

Built-in APA Style in Microsoft Word

In a word document, click on the **References** tab, then from *Insert Citation-Style* select the format you need such as APA Sixth Edition from the drop-down menu. Then click Add New Source under *Insert Citation*, input all your references by source format such as Journal Article, Book, or Web Site, etc. The information you typed in will be saved automatically.

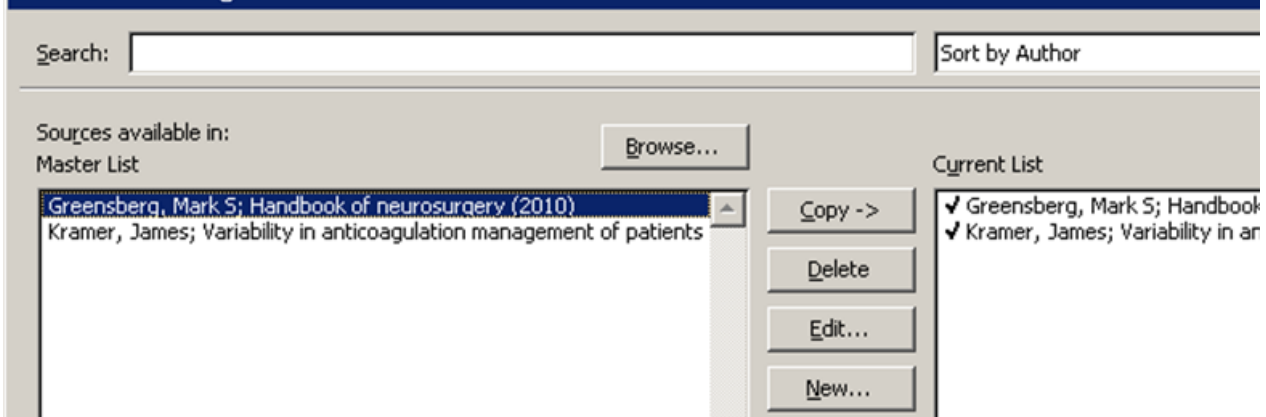


At the end of your paper, click **Bibliography** tab and select Insert Bibliography or Work cited and your references will be on the paper.



To modify or delete a bibliography, click **Manage Sources** then select the respective citation to edit/delete.

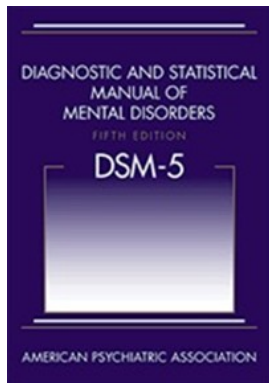
