A presentation on the candidate's behalf will be made to the Institute's Board of Directors at its December meeting. The presenter must be an AIA member and will be neither a principal, nor an employee of the nominee's firm as stated in the Rules of the Board governing the Gold Medal program.

Submit supporting documentation online as a single PDF file—max 10 MB—and include the following:

- one-page nomination letter, addressed to the jury chair, summarizing the firm's contributions
- brief biography of the firm's achievements and awards (max two pages)
- statement or list of the candidate's achievements and awards (max two pages)
- descriptive statements and images of the firm's work—including site plans—for each project represented accompanied by at least three images
- five one-page letters of support addressed to the jury chair



- other miscellaneous material—including clippings and articles—is optional but may not exceed three pages
