RABBI'S FORUM



Rabbi Anthony Fratello

One of my great joys is in working with our 10th Grade Confirmation Students. They not only are at a crucial time in their lives and development, they are beginning to ask those questions about life and existence that can only be engendered in those about to take their first tentative steps into the unknown.

There are some questions they ask that surprise me—Rabbi do you keep Kosher all the time? And there are other questions that are fairly regular; they come up year after year.

One common question our teens deal with, is a question that many adults ponder as well. It is a question and topic I have visited many times in sermons and lectures, and one that hits at the heart of our being—Rabbi, did God really create the world as the Torah tells us?

The Book of Genesis, and Jewish Tradition as a whole, reinforces the idea that at the beginning of time, God created the Universe in 6 Days and rested on the 7th. We mark time, the passage of days and weeks, based on this understanding. The obvious challenge to this, of course, is the fact that science tells us a VERY different story. Science tells us that the world came into existence over a very slow process that spans 4.5 billion years. The existence of life on this planet, moreover, is the product of the very slow and patient work of evolution.

For many people, the discrepancy between these two stories is enough to turn them completely off of religion; and here I mean religion in general, not just Judaism. “How,” or, “Why should I put my faith in a bunch of fairy tales that aren’t even remotely true?” That is a good question, but as I have been

went to point out, not the right approach. The goal of the Book of Genesis is NOT to teach us a history lesson, but rather a theological lesson. The moral of the First Chapter of Genesis is not how God created the world, but rather God created the world. The details don’t matter so much.

Before you either applaud me for my intellectual honesty, or renounce me for going off the deep-end, know that I am hardly the only Religious Leader who seeks to find a harmony between science and religion.

There is an organization—The Clergy Letter Project—that every year promotes what is known as “Evolution Weekend” to highlight those people of faith who do not find contradiction between the Bible and Darwin. Rather, we find harmony and that each informs the other. Each one tells us something the other cannot. Darwin teaches us HOW the universe came into existence. The Bible teaches us WHY.

Evolution Weekend this year is February 10-12. The goal for us is to recognize and understand that our lives and our existence are a miracle. No matter how we might have come into existence. Take some time, and give thanks.

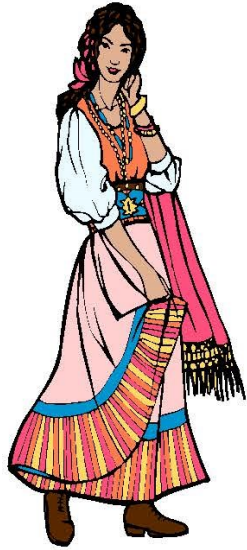
