Minutes of the Annual Meeting, November 13th, 2016

Once again, we met at Belhurst Castle in Geneva for the 2016 Annual Meeting. Nine members, 5 associate members and 5 guests from the Finger Lakes Section attended. We were pleased to welcome two members of the Niagara Section, Art Bourget and Hans Mobius who joined us. The meeting was called to order by President Bob Handzo at 2:PM. The yearly Board Member election was the first order of Business. Menzer Doud introduced the current Board: President-Bob Handzo; Vice-President-Don Klug; Secretary/Treasurer-Judy Handzo. Prior nominations received before the Meeting and nominations from the floor were requested, none were received. Voting was conducted, the current Board slate was passed unanimously and will serve for another year. Oscar and Peggy Raffo were introduced as our new Newsletter Editors. Dave Kliment will continue as our Website Coordinator. Bob introduced our "Member of the Year", Bill Wayman. Unfortunately Bill received his award plague from National prior to the Meeting so we were unable to surprise him. A well-deserved award for a member always willing to help with automotive and other questions and problems. Bob thanked Bill for his April tech session; Simon Pontin for hosting the May tech session at his facility; Red Kosinski for being the yearly picnic "host with the most"; Don Klug for his search for new Board members; Vickie Patridge for breathing life back into a defunct newsletter and the following 4 years of her Editorship; Sally McFarland for her well attended Taughannock gathering and all her ideas for past and future club events; Dave Kliment for his emailing our colorful newsletter and other notices and for FLMBCA members who support the club by attending our gatherings. Hans Mobius was introduced to the group. He is an advocate for ridding NY front license plates from our cars as a cost saver for both owners and the state. His presentation was well researched and elicited much comment from the members. He requests that we write to our area legislators and let them know of our interest and support of such a change. A full financial report will be available at the end of January 2017 when we file with the National office. The names of members receiving membership pins were read. Menzer received a 25 year pin and Don Klug a 10 year pin (see list elsewhere in this newsletter). Lots of talk about possible 2017 events followed. Since the February lunch gathering doesn't appeal to the number of members it once did and the weather is undependable we will not continue with this event. Bill Wayman will host an "Open Shop" gathering in late April. The Sonnenberg Car Show on Father's Day in June is a big crowd pleaser and we'll join with Niagara Section again for this event. July is definite for our annual picnic at Red's home. Among other suggestions the following seemed to generate interest: A jazz cruise on the Erie Canal from Pittsford; a brunch cruise on Seneca Lake; 3 laps in your car at Watkins Glen on Opening Weekend, April 8 and 9 for \$25.00 to benefit The Watkins Glen International Race Foundation; Letchworth tour with lunch at the Glen Iris in September (because we enjoyed it so much previously); a reenactment of the original Gran Prix at Watkins Glen, September 8, 9 10 and more Syracuse area events with lunch (is the ride on the Skaneateles Mail Boat still available?). All ideas and event carry throughs from members are welcomed and greatly appreciated. All attendees received a new style Mercedes-Benz key fob courtesy of Mercedes-Benz of Rochester.
