DID YOU KNOW?

GEWA paid \$9,797.08 to the Blind Industries and Services of Maryland required by the HEW regulations relating to the Randolph-Sheppard Act Amendments of 1974. The vending services in several Goddard buildings are by federal law under the Randolph-Sheppard Act and GEWA has to pay a penalty to the state because it does not have a blind concessionaire.
